Survey Methodology

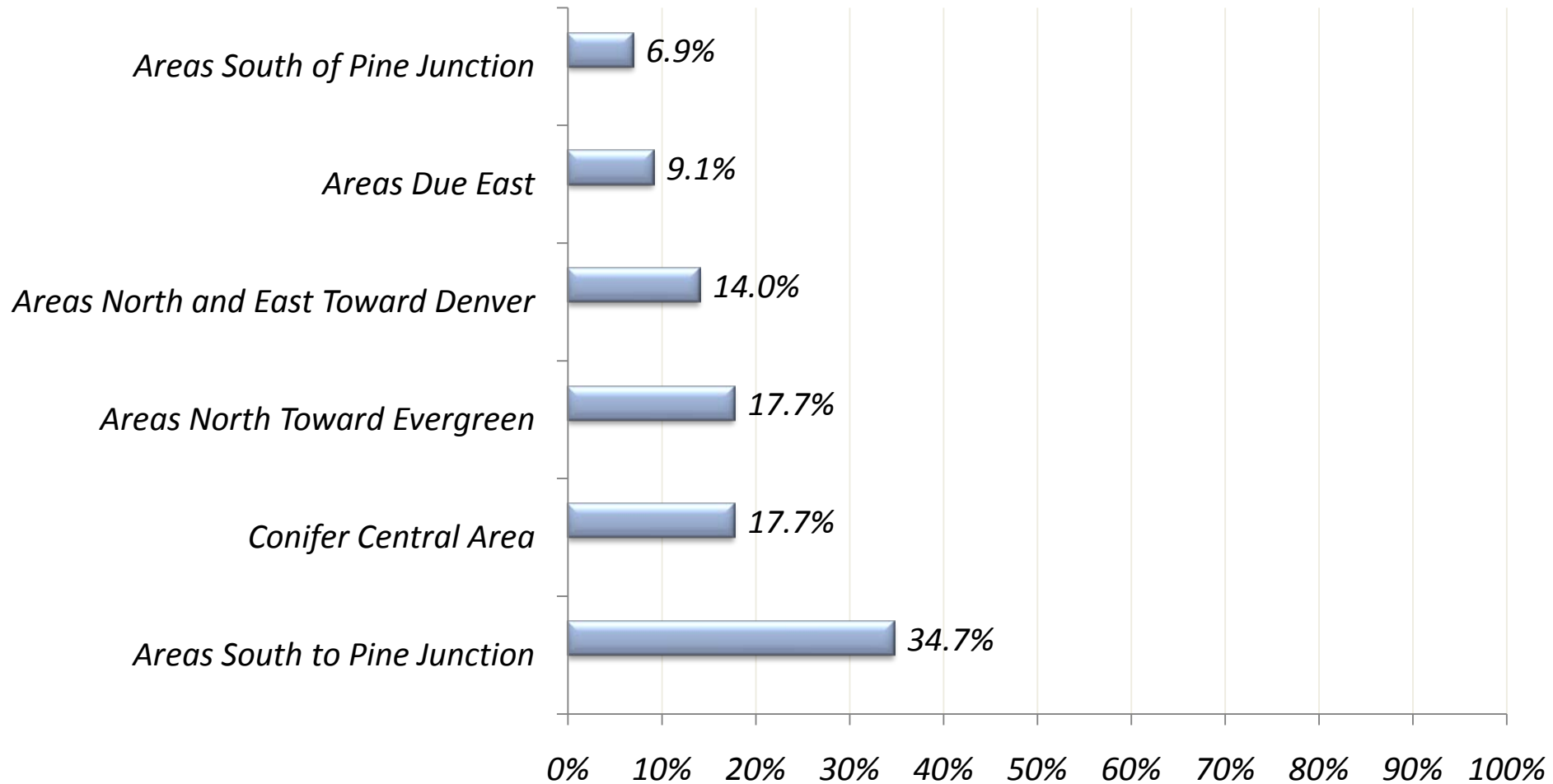
- This is not a scientifically validated survey. We used a convenience sample . . . anyone in the Conifer area could fill it out. We were interested in hearing from as many community residents as possible.
- Therefore, these findings can't be generalized to all Conifer area residents.
- Whenever possible we compared these responses to the 2006 survey and to the U.S. Census data for the Conifer area.
- Similarities between this survey and either the 2006 survey or the U.S. Census information suggests that survey respondents and the overall community are of similar makeup.

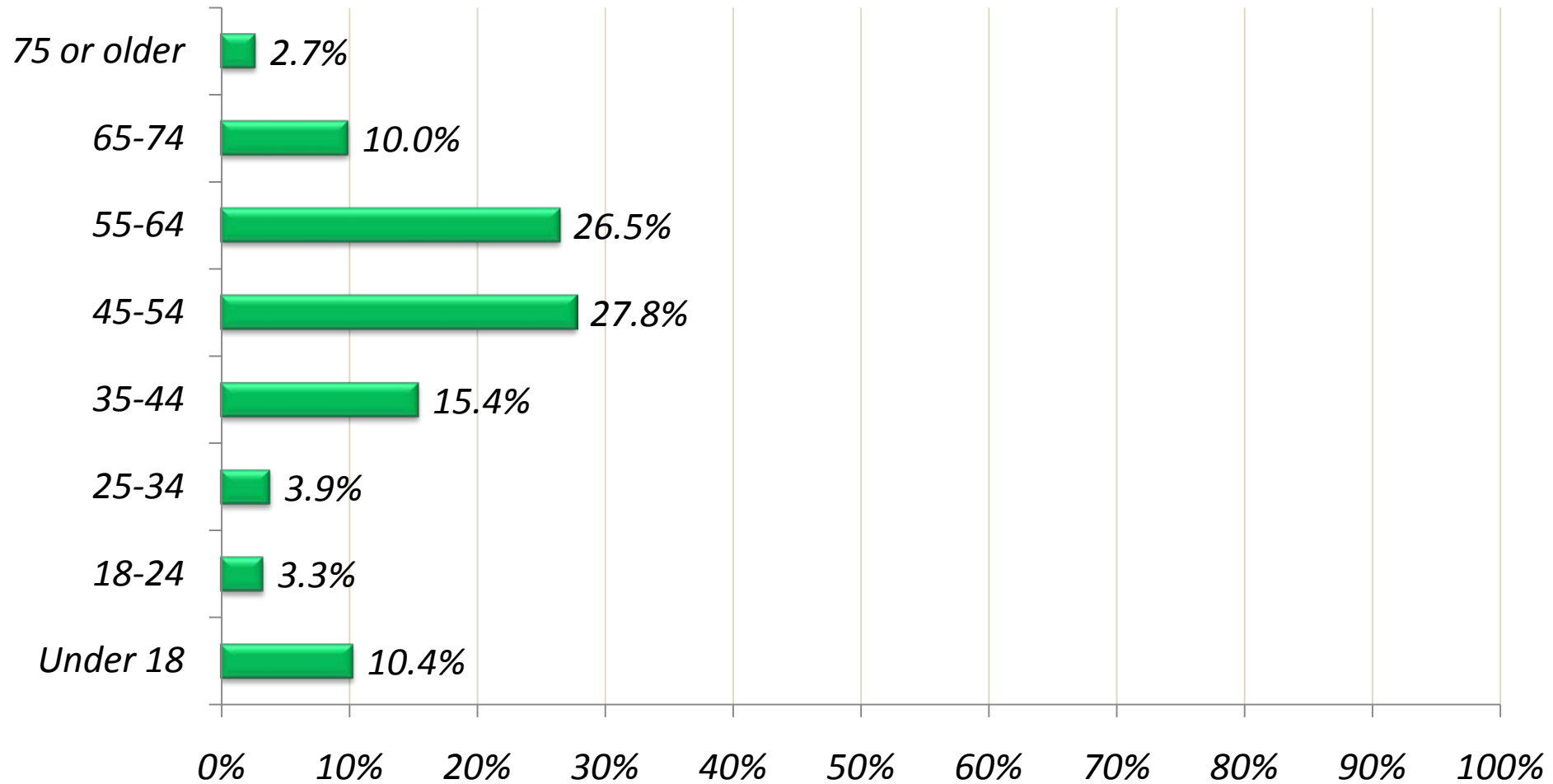

Age of Respondents

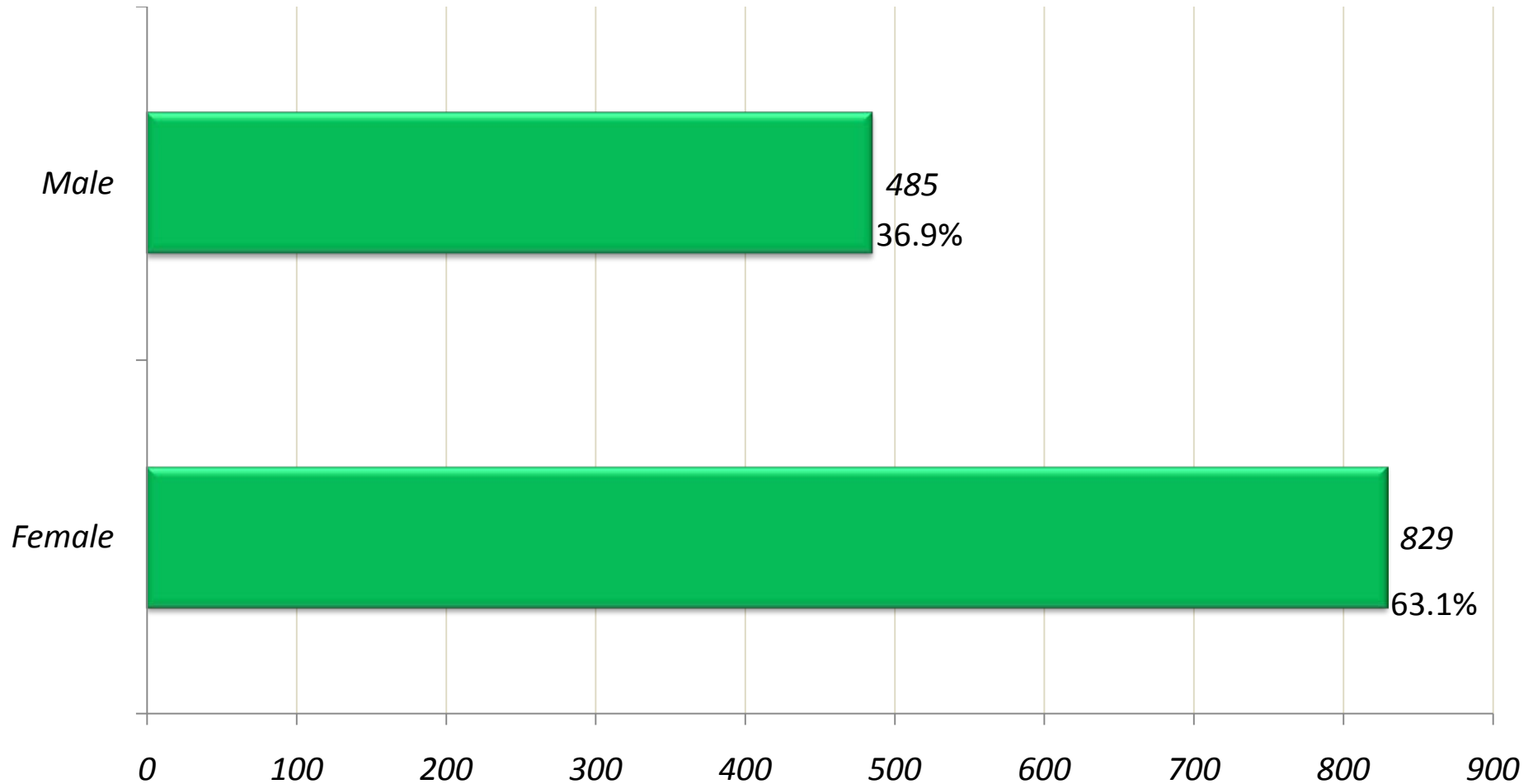

Gender of Respondent



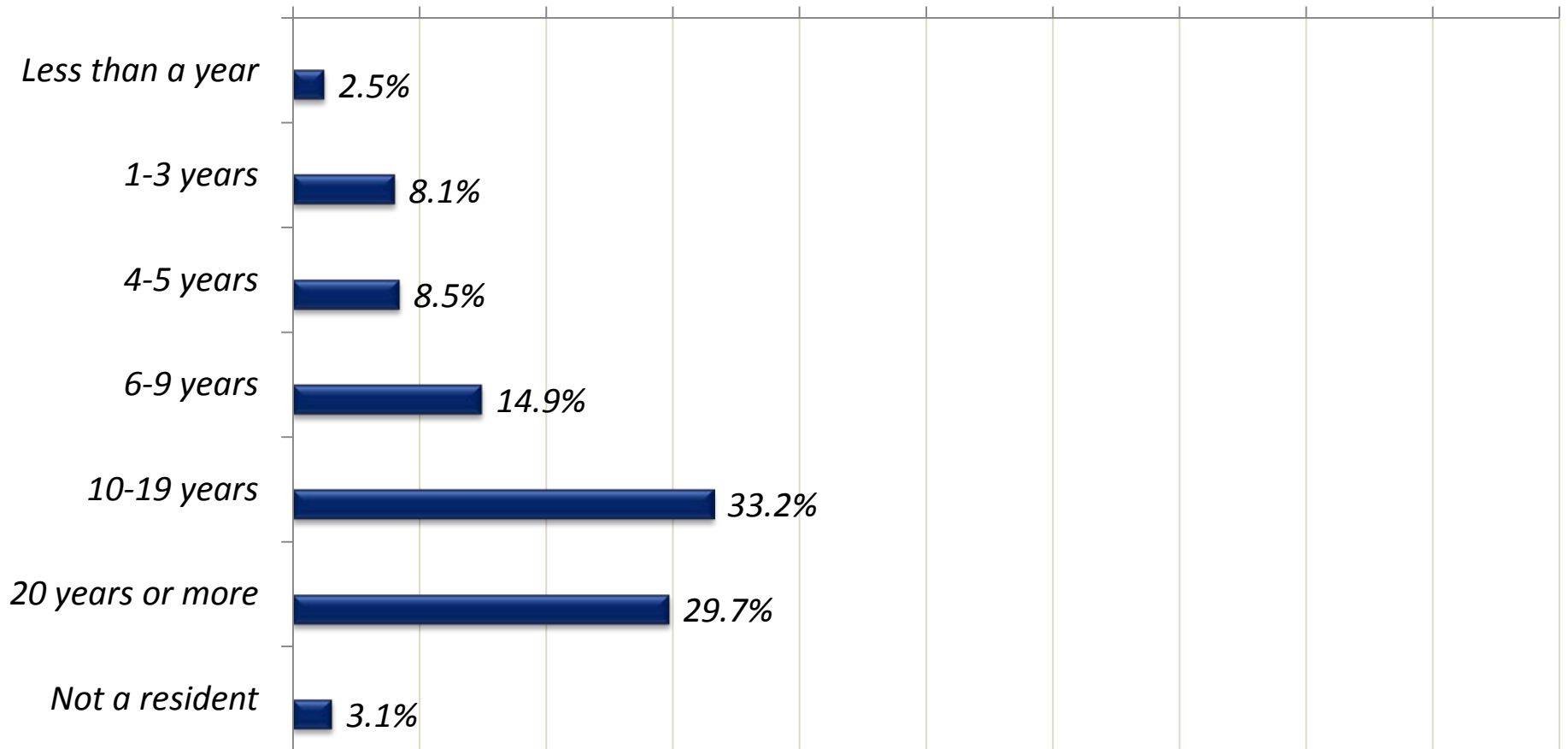

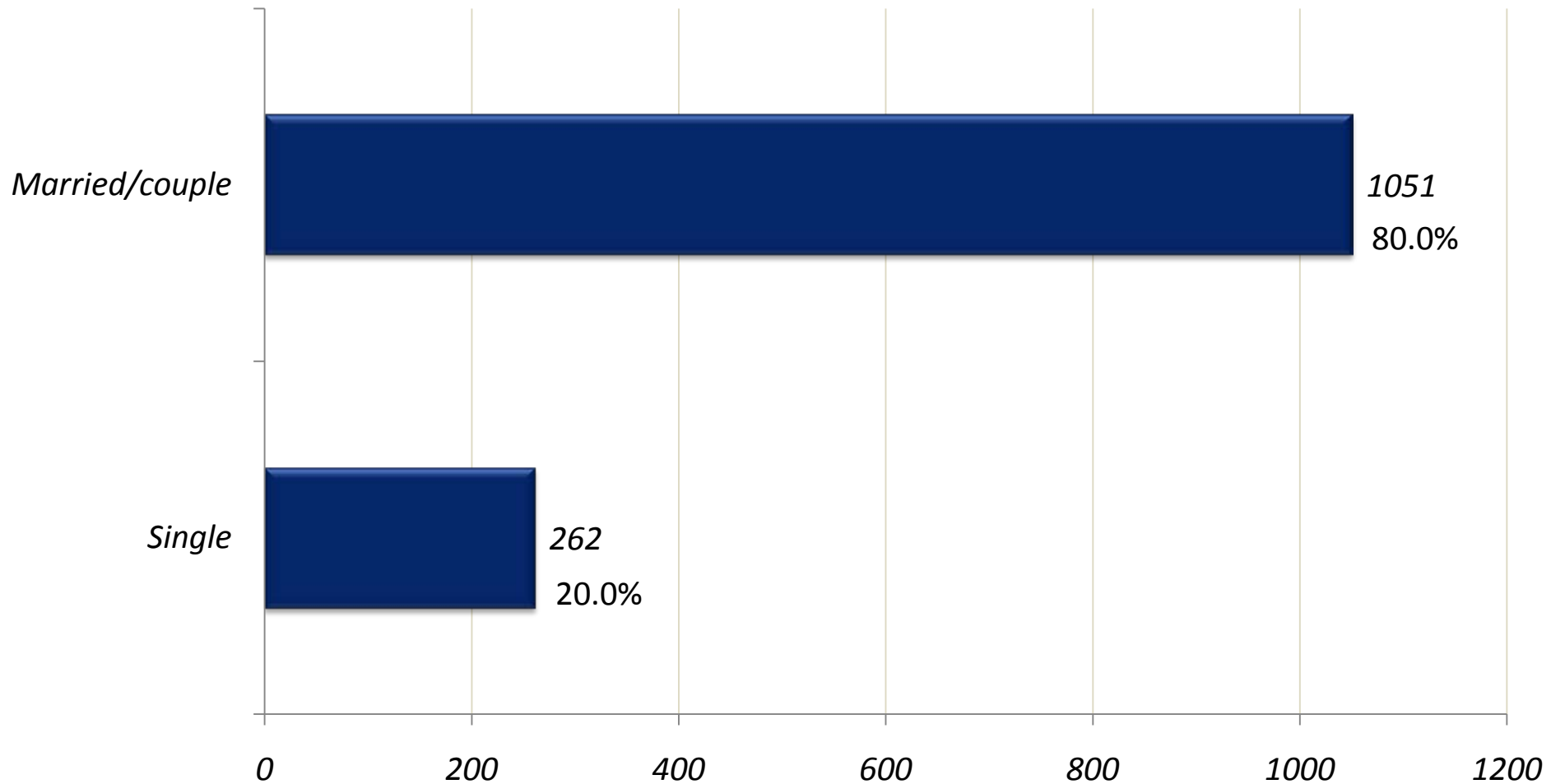

Family Status



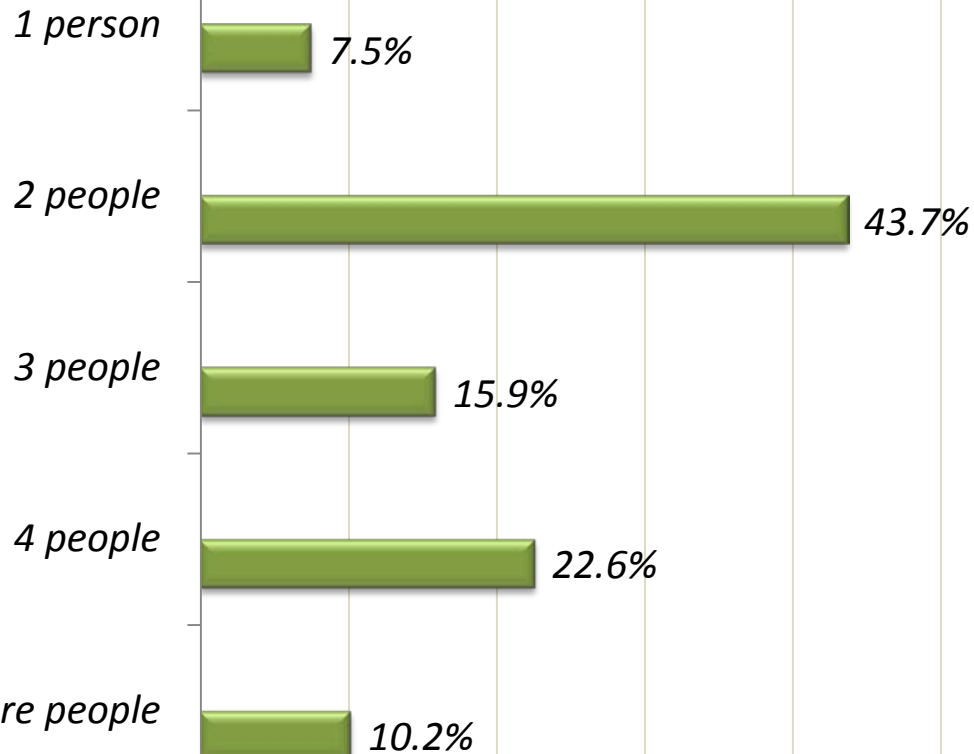

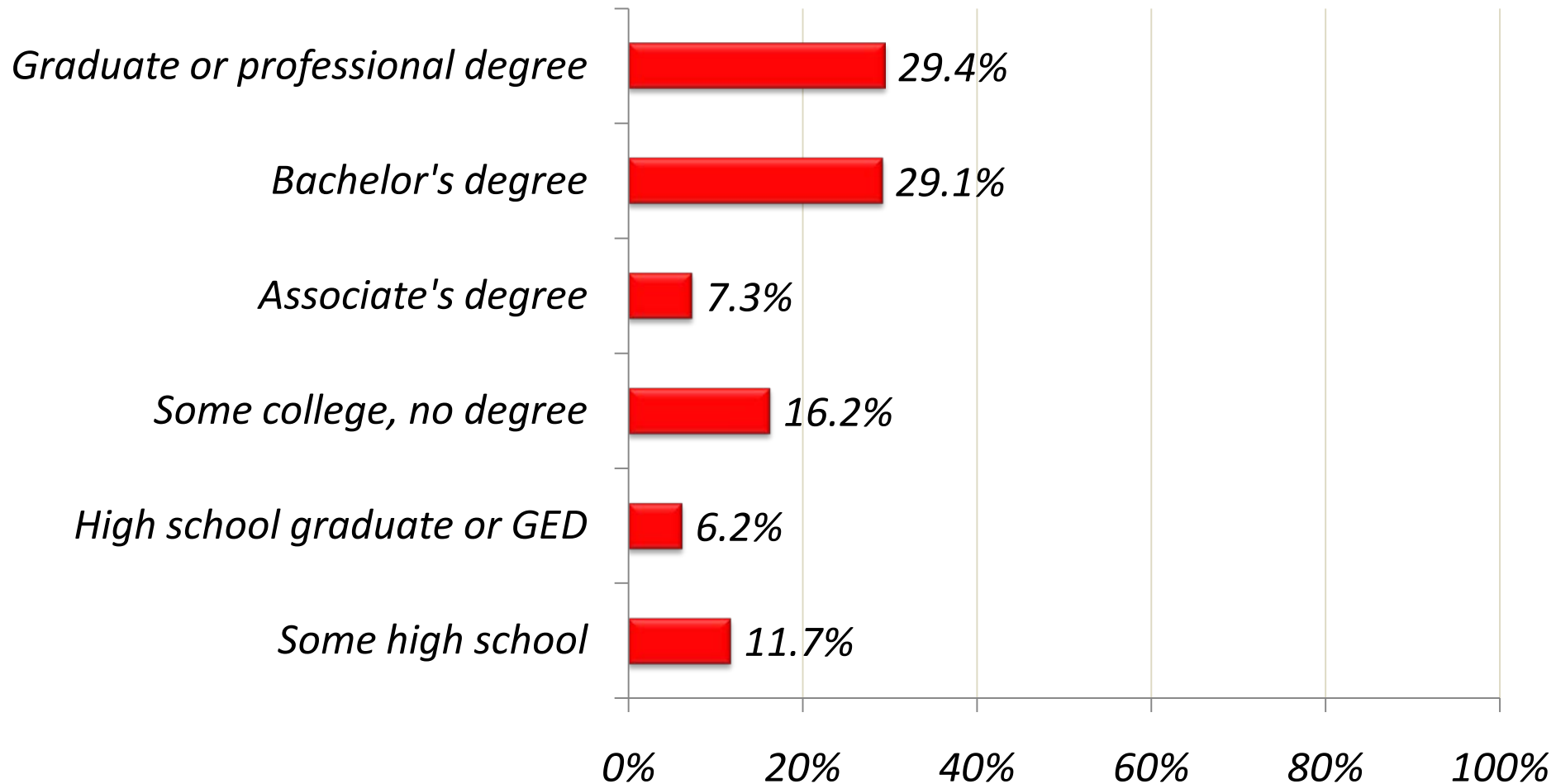

Within the Conifer 285 corridor but not at home



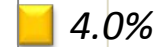
Outside the Conifer 285 corridor

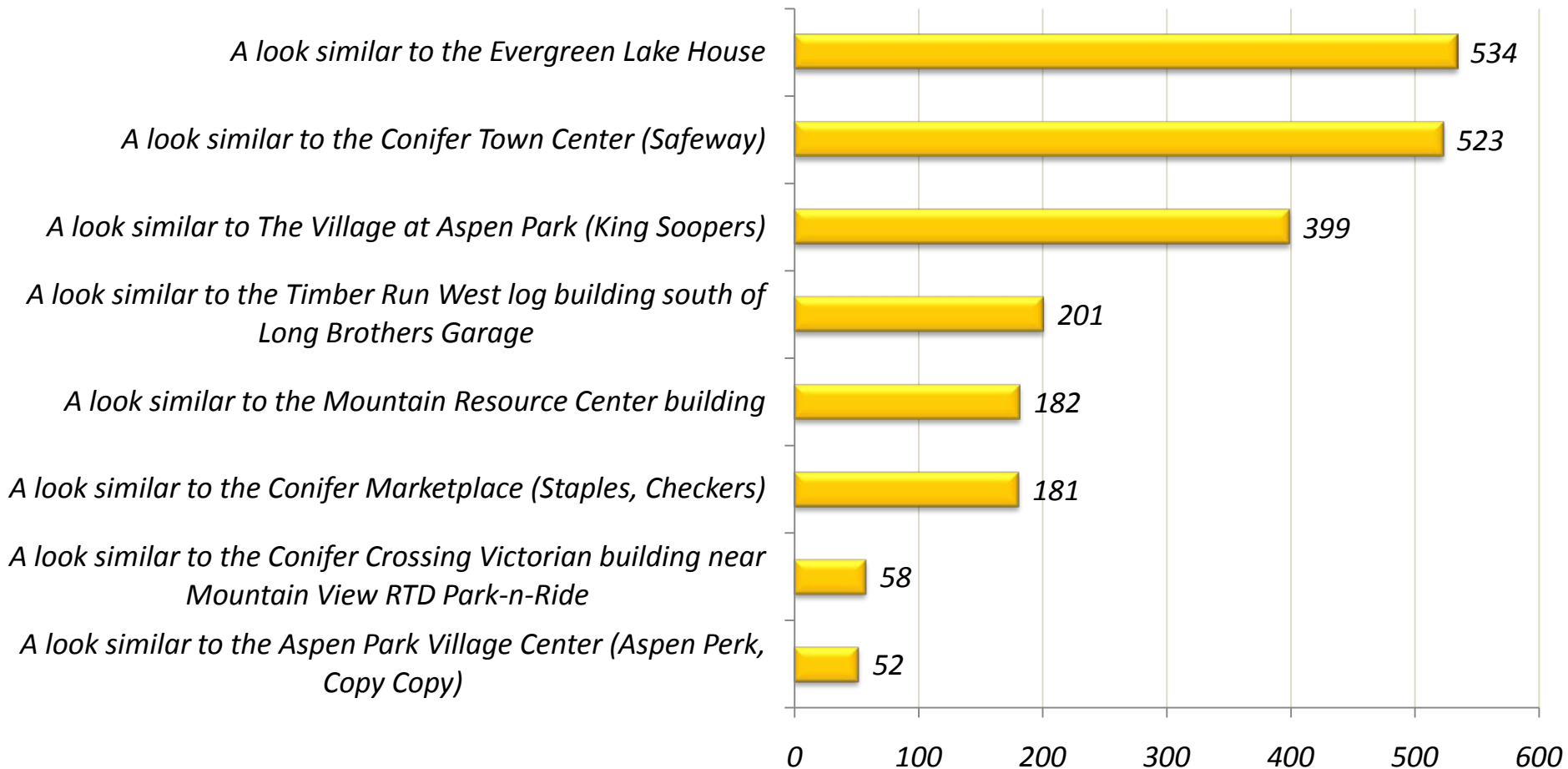

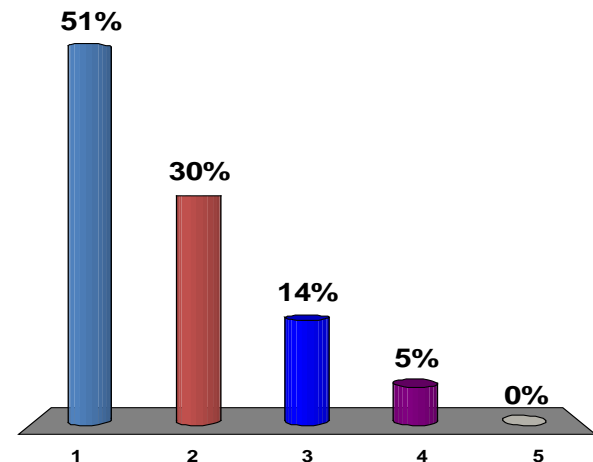




Conifer Community Survey— Town Hall Meeting Poll

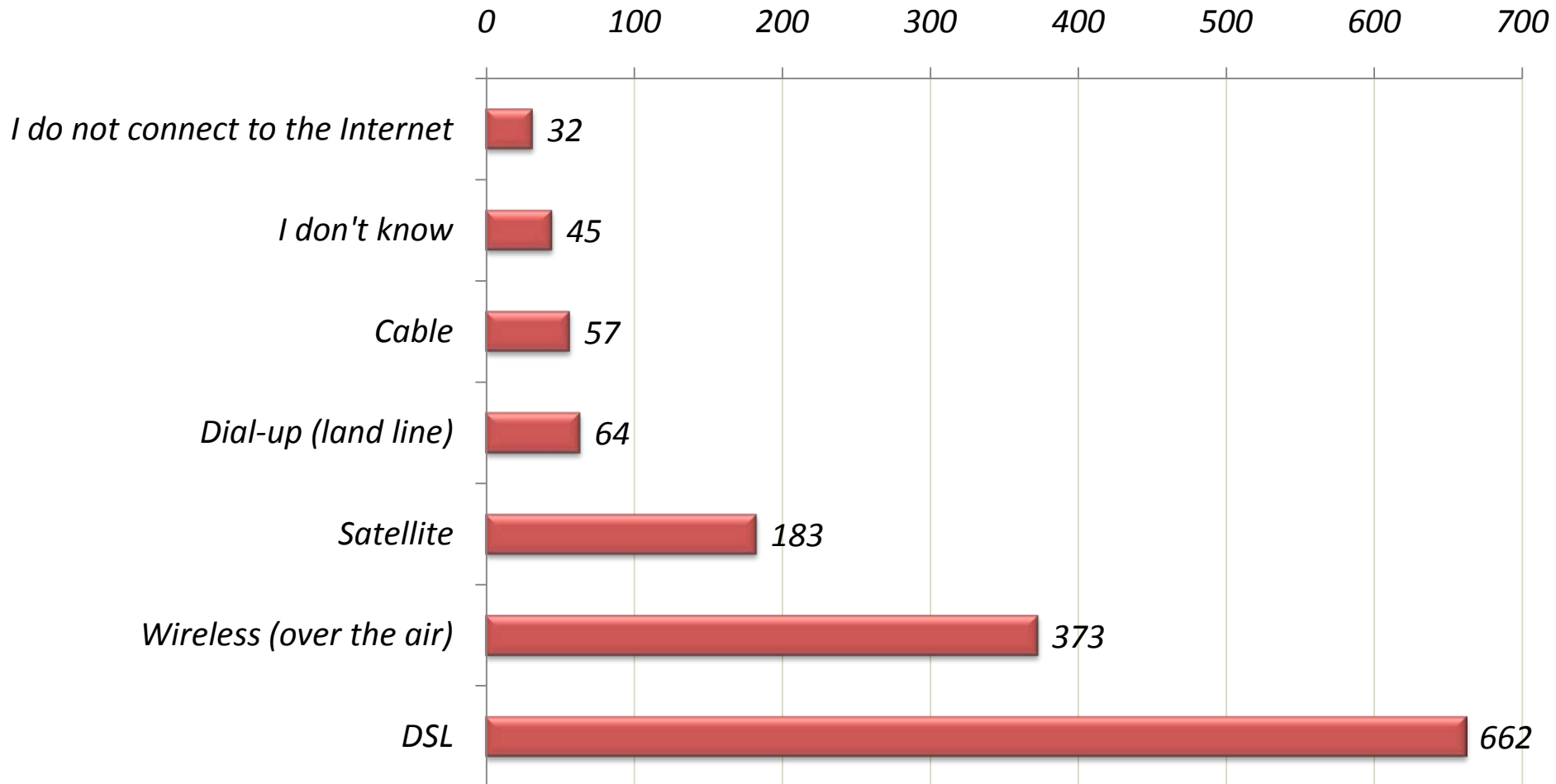

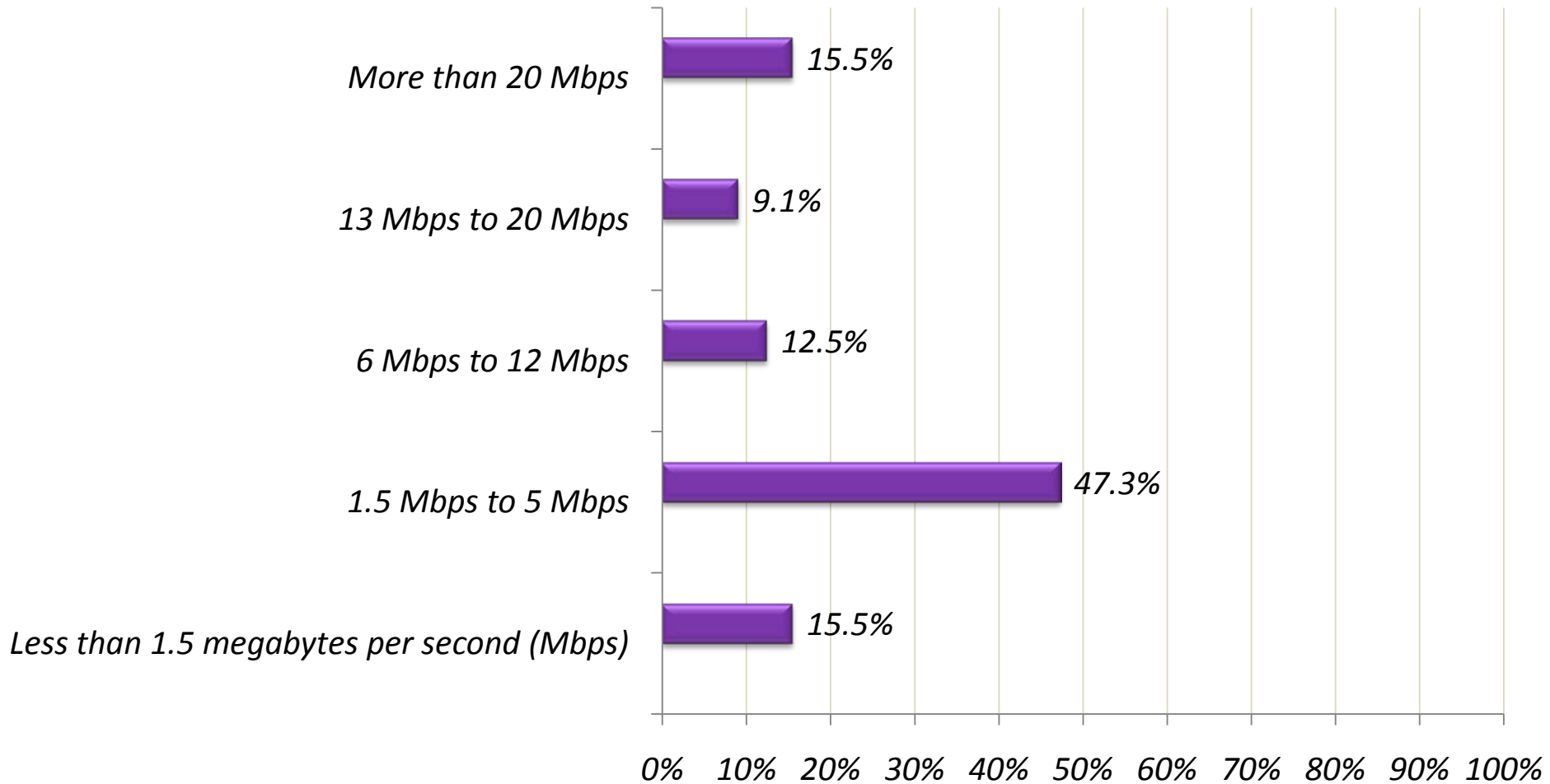

Internet Speed

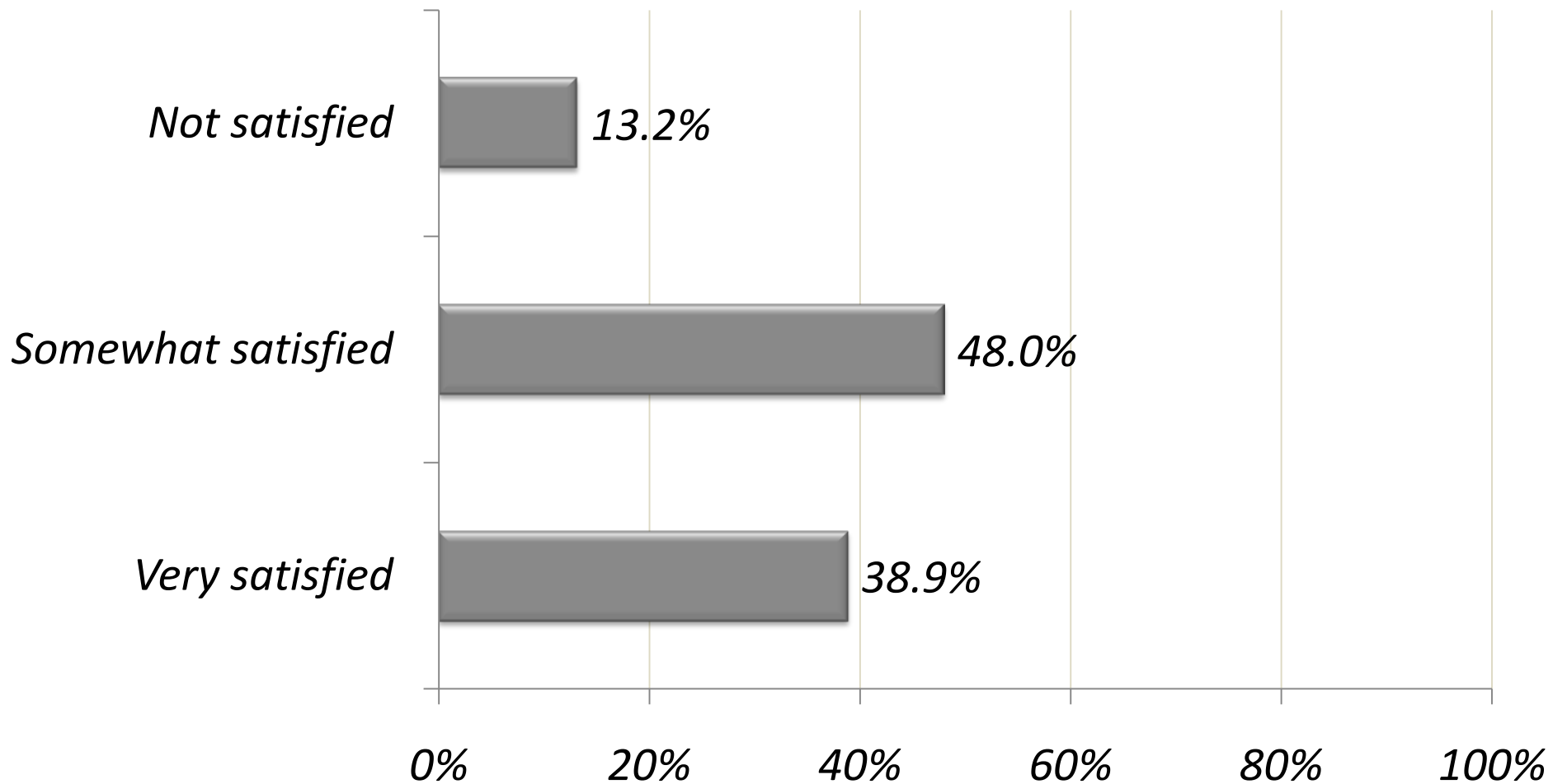

Satisfaction with Connectivity

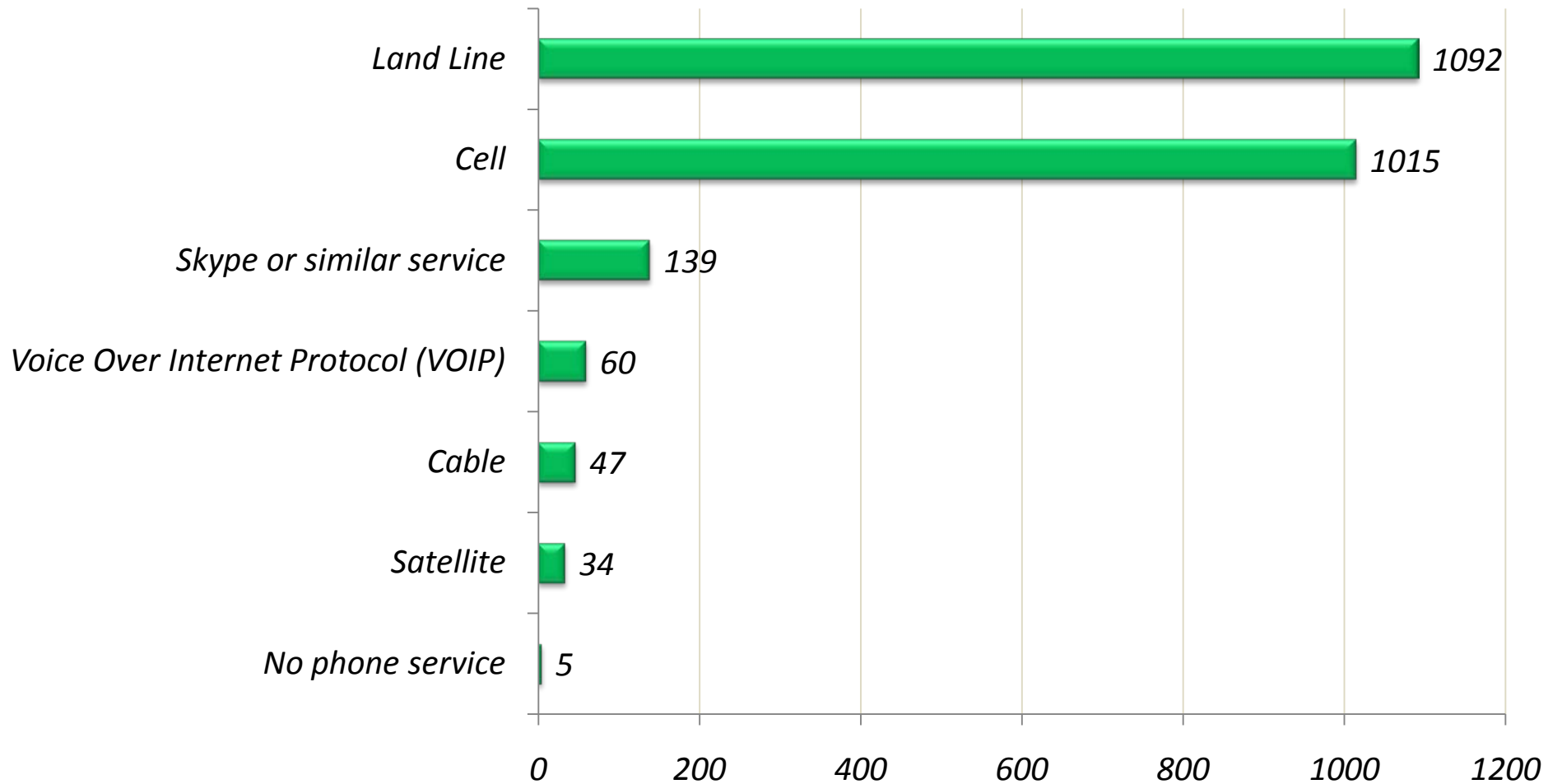

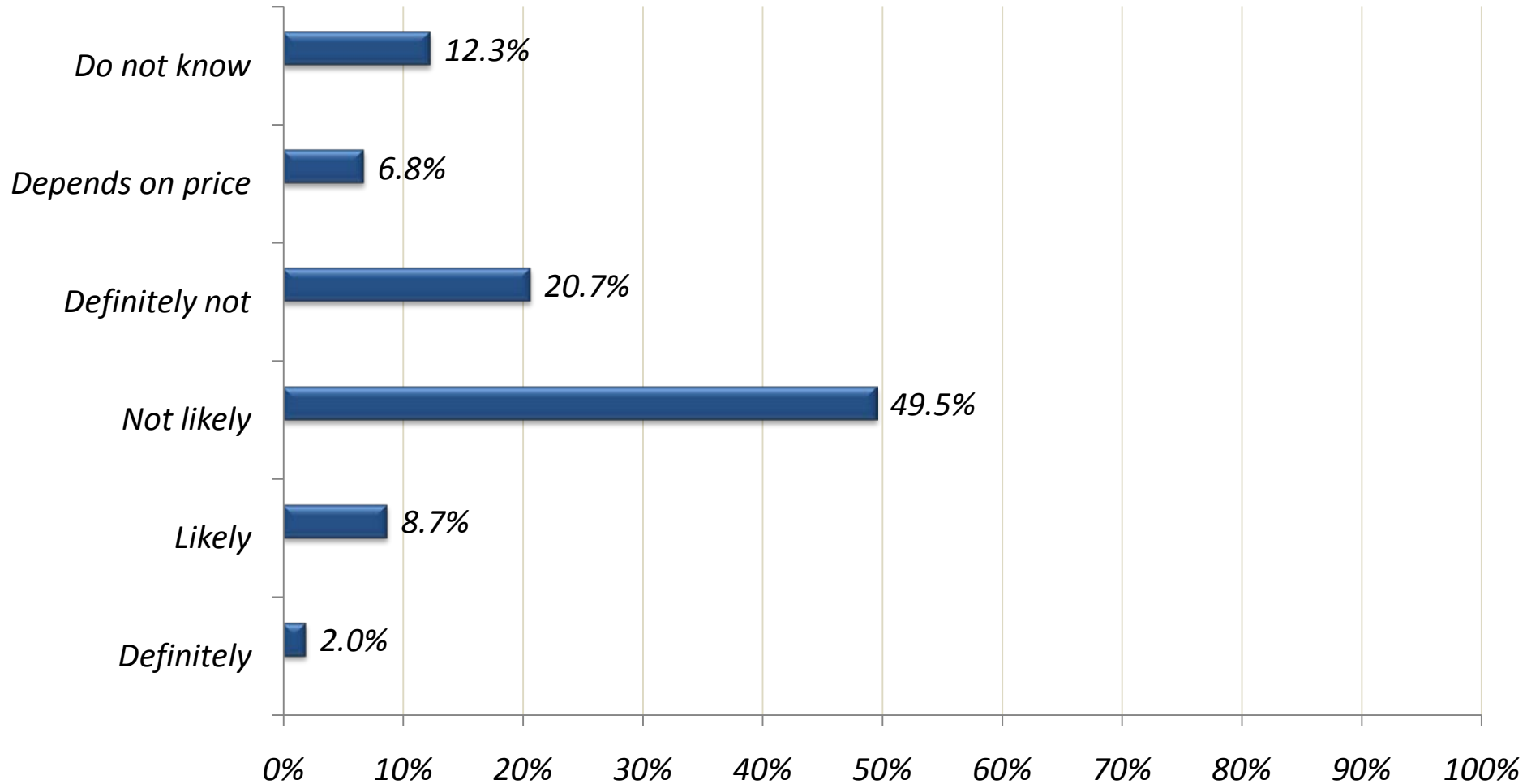

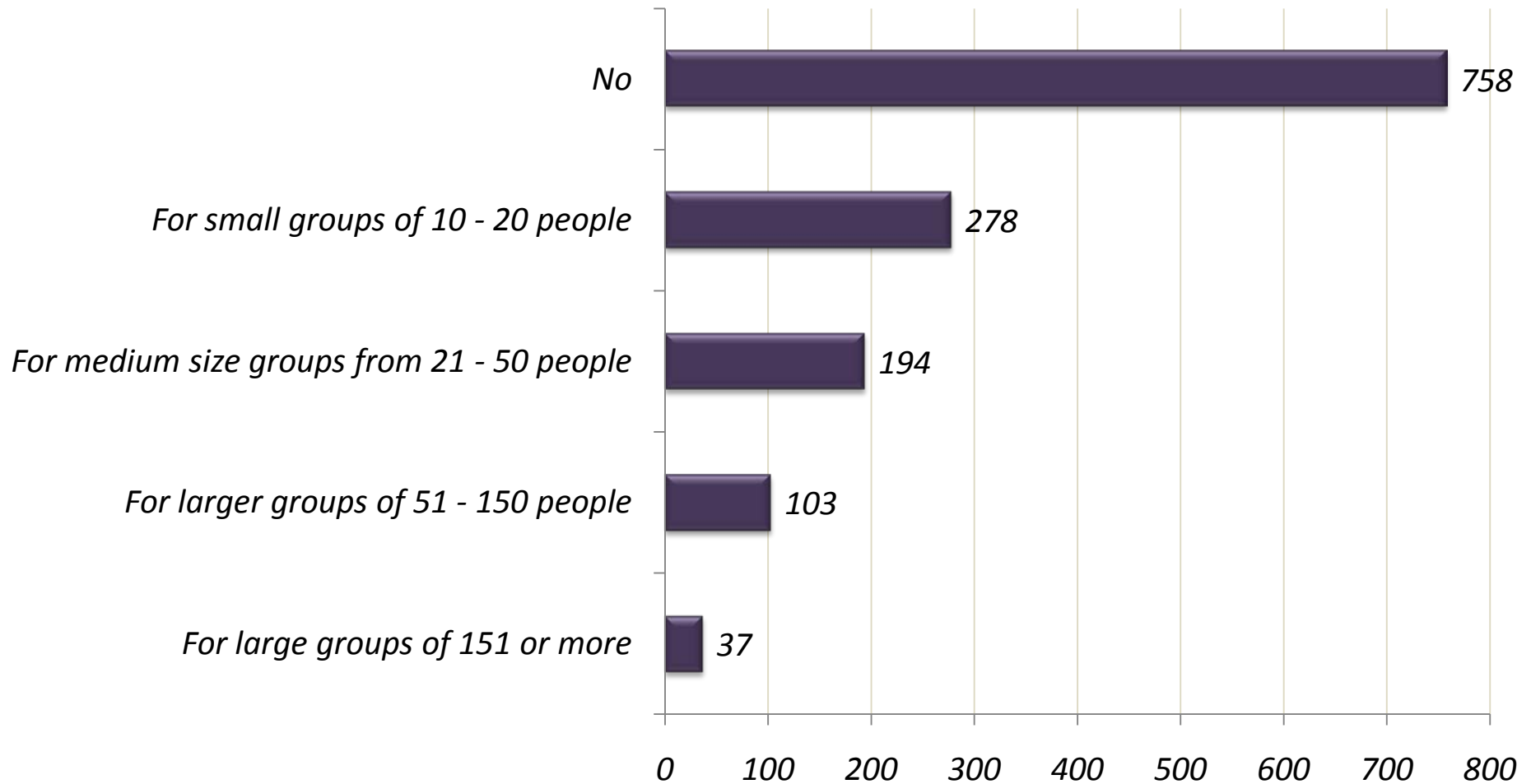

Likely To Use Rentable Space

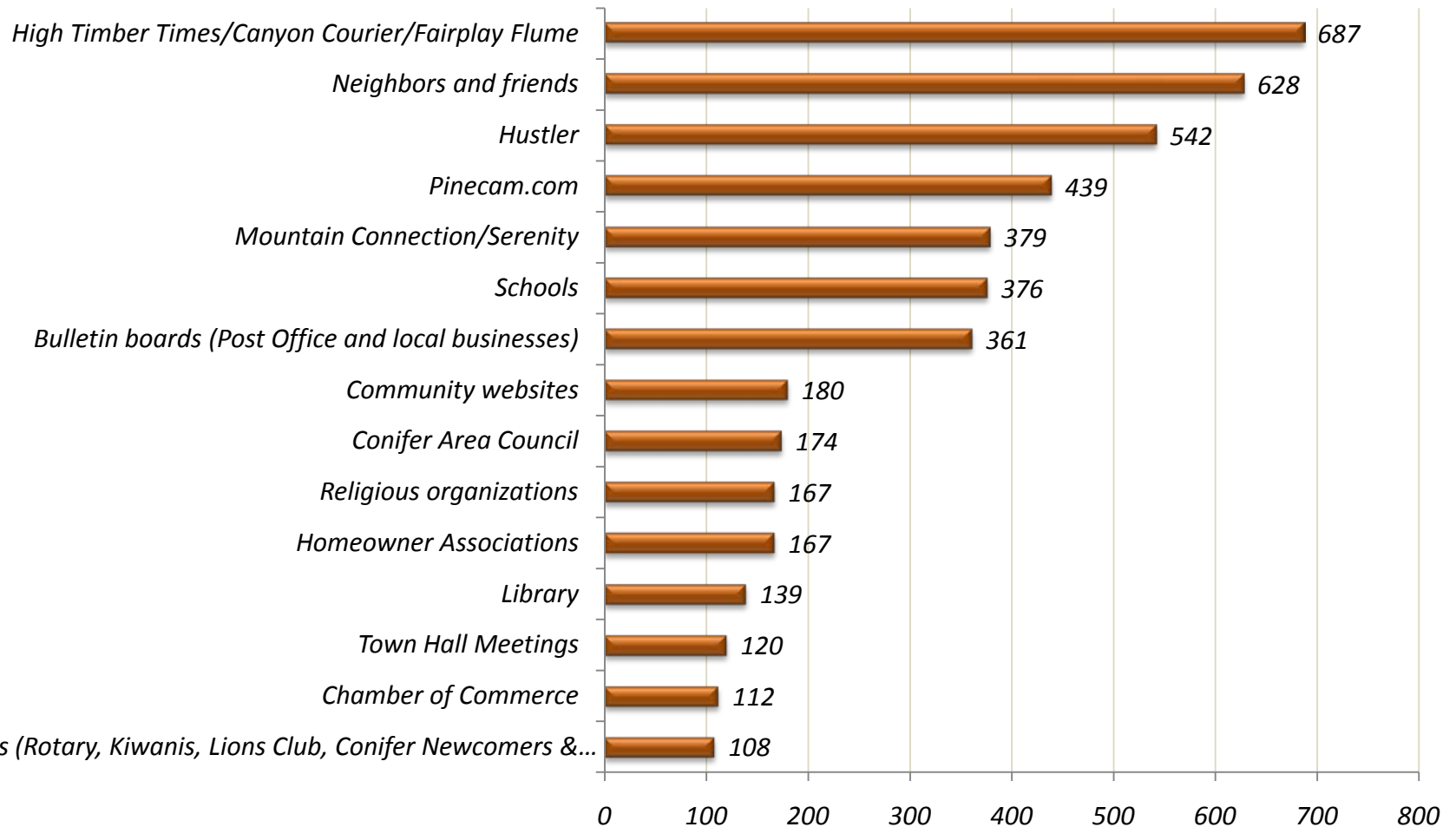

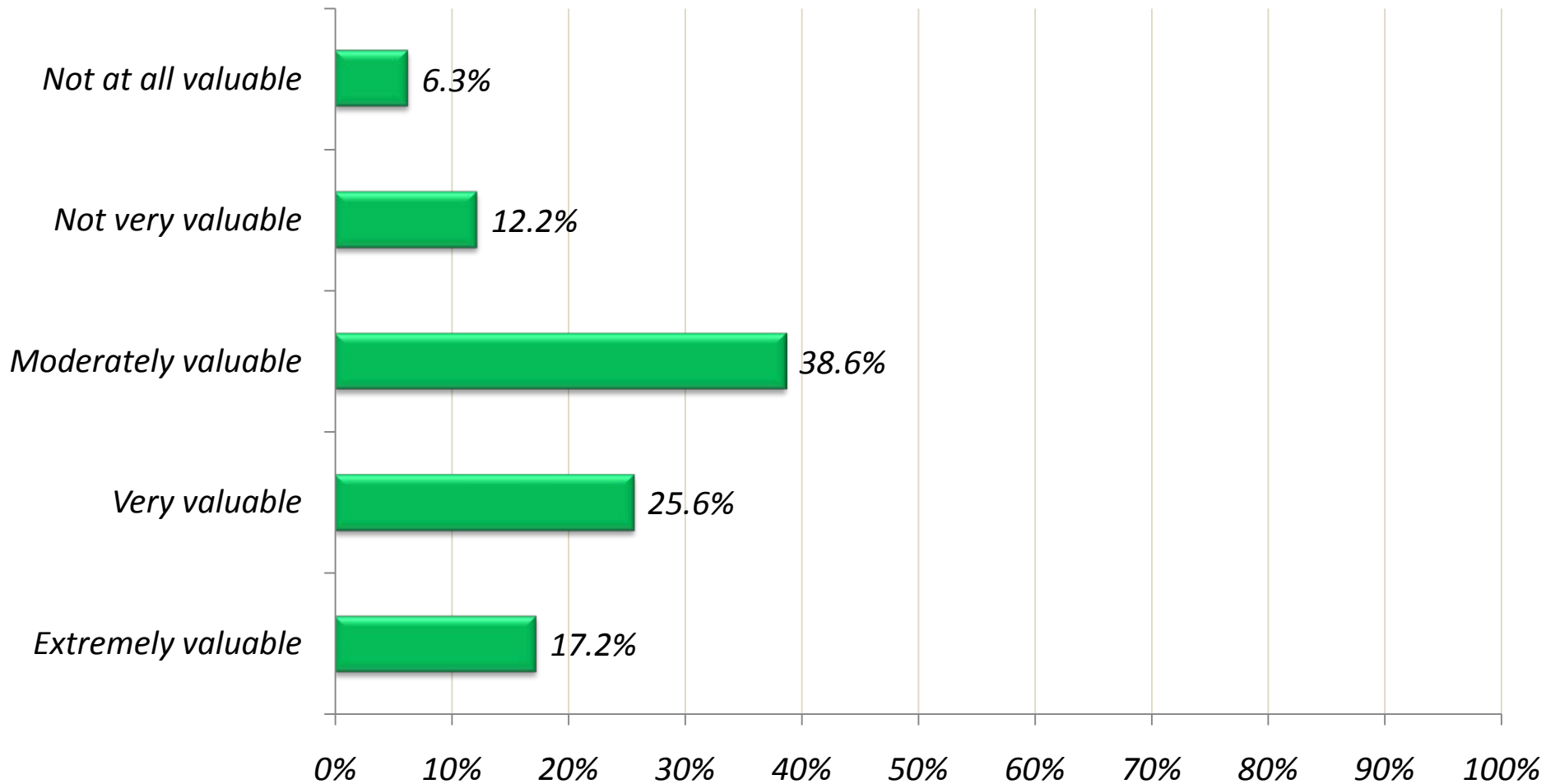

Value of an Internet-Based Calendar of Events

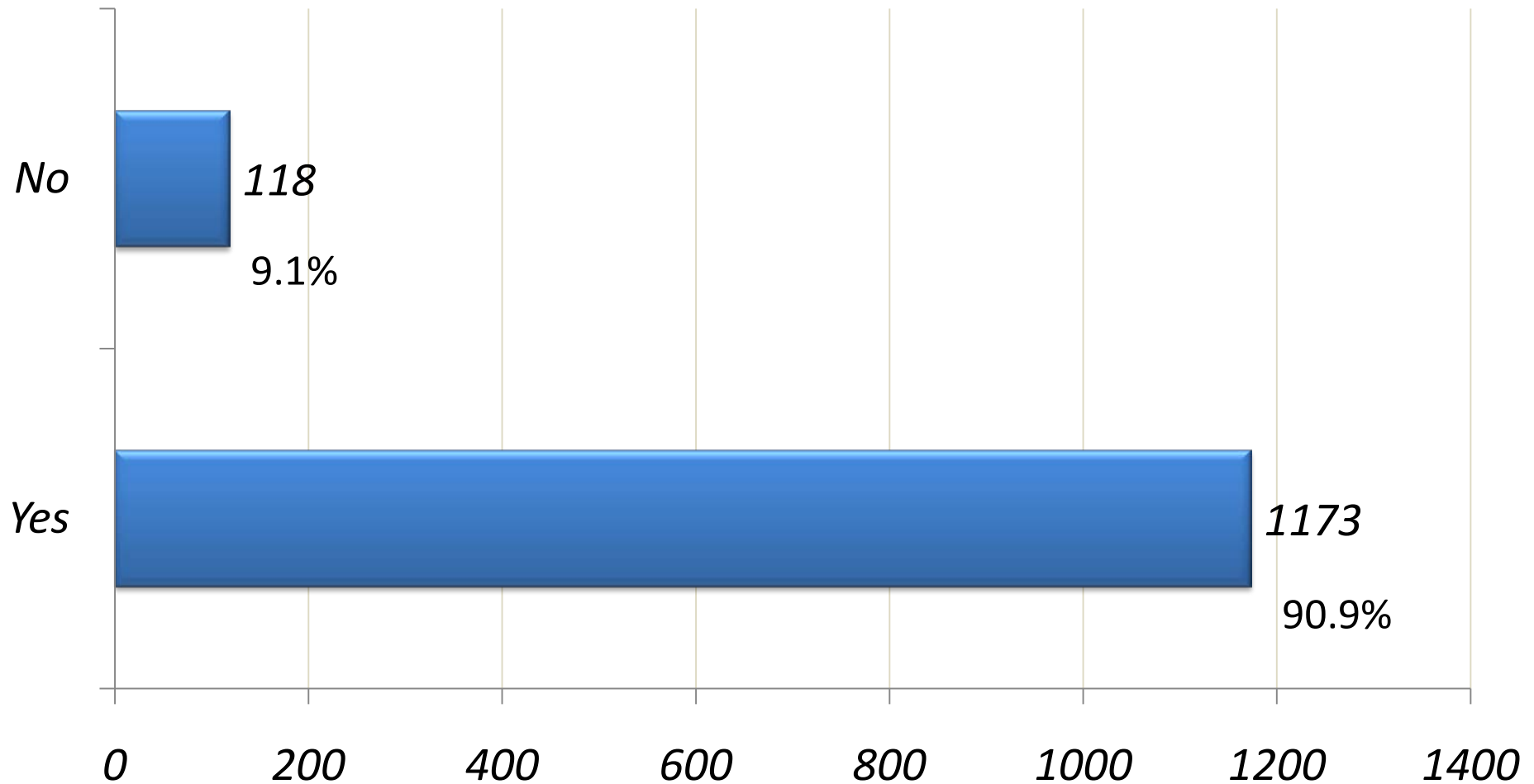

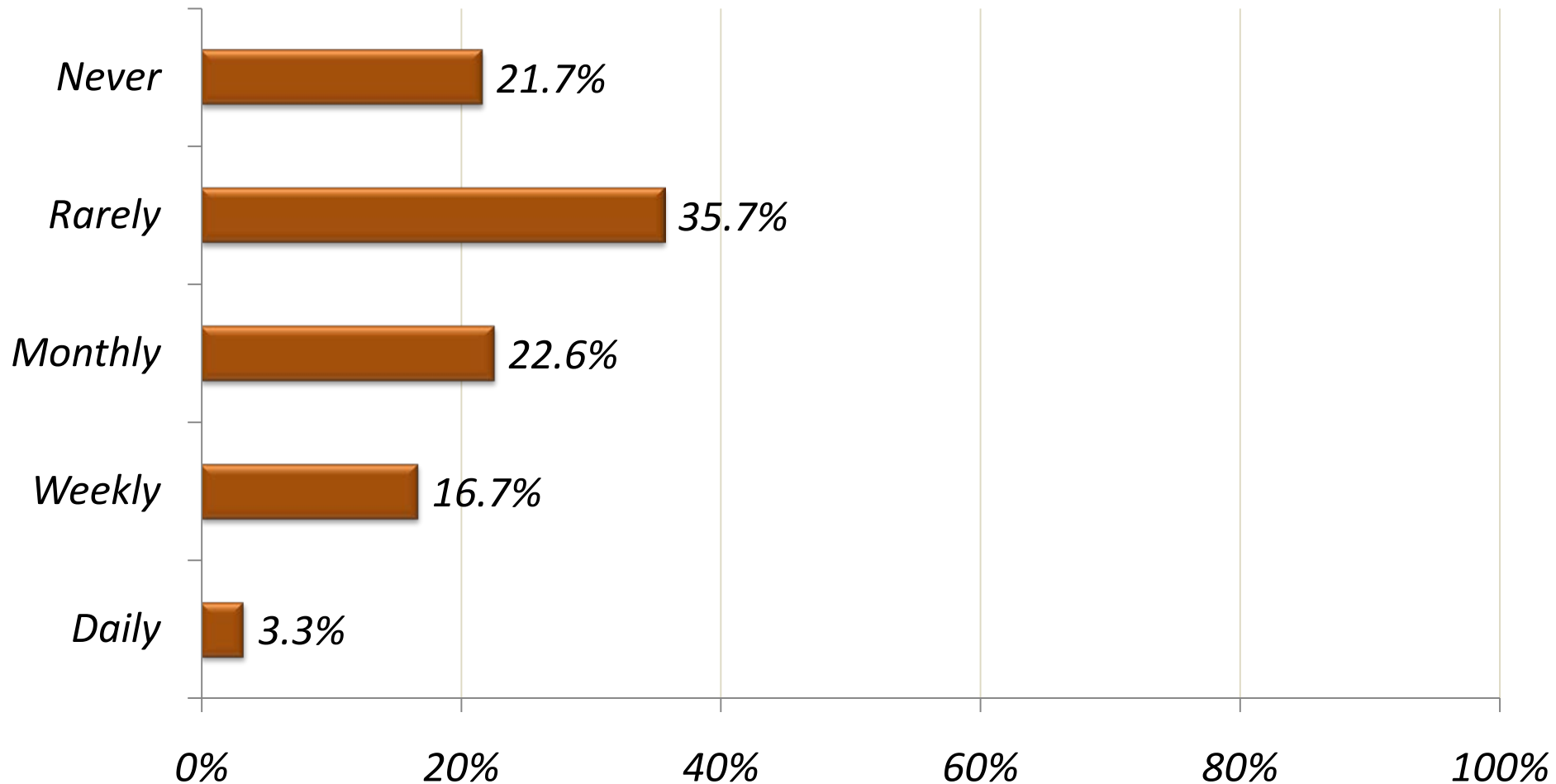

Frequency of Use of the Library

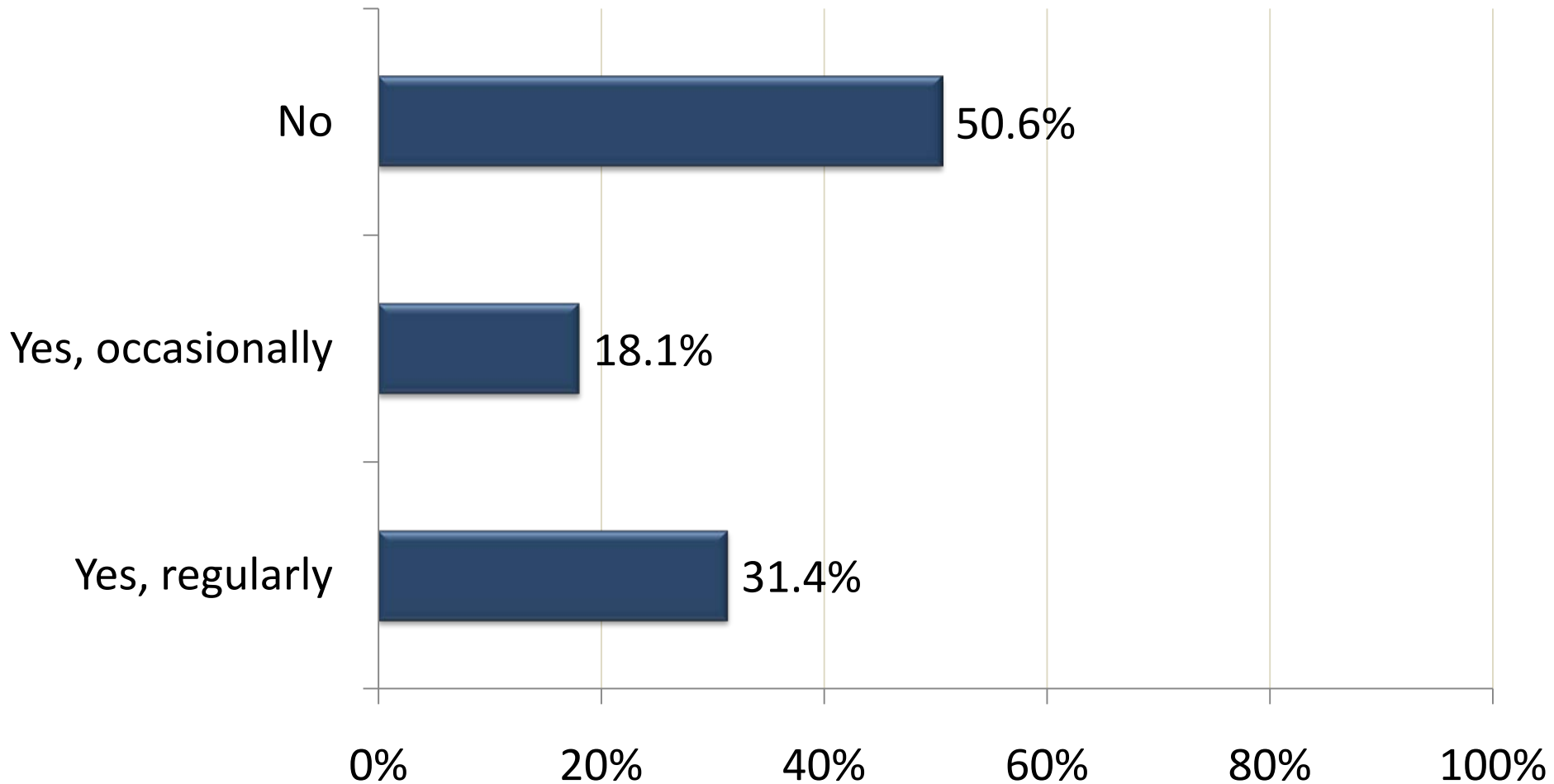

Use of Old Recycling Center

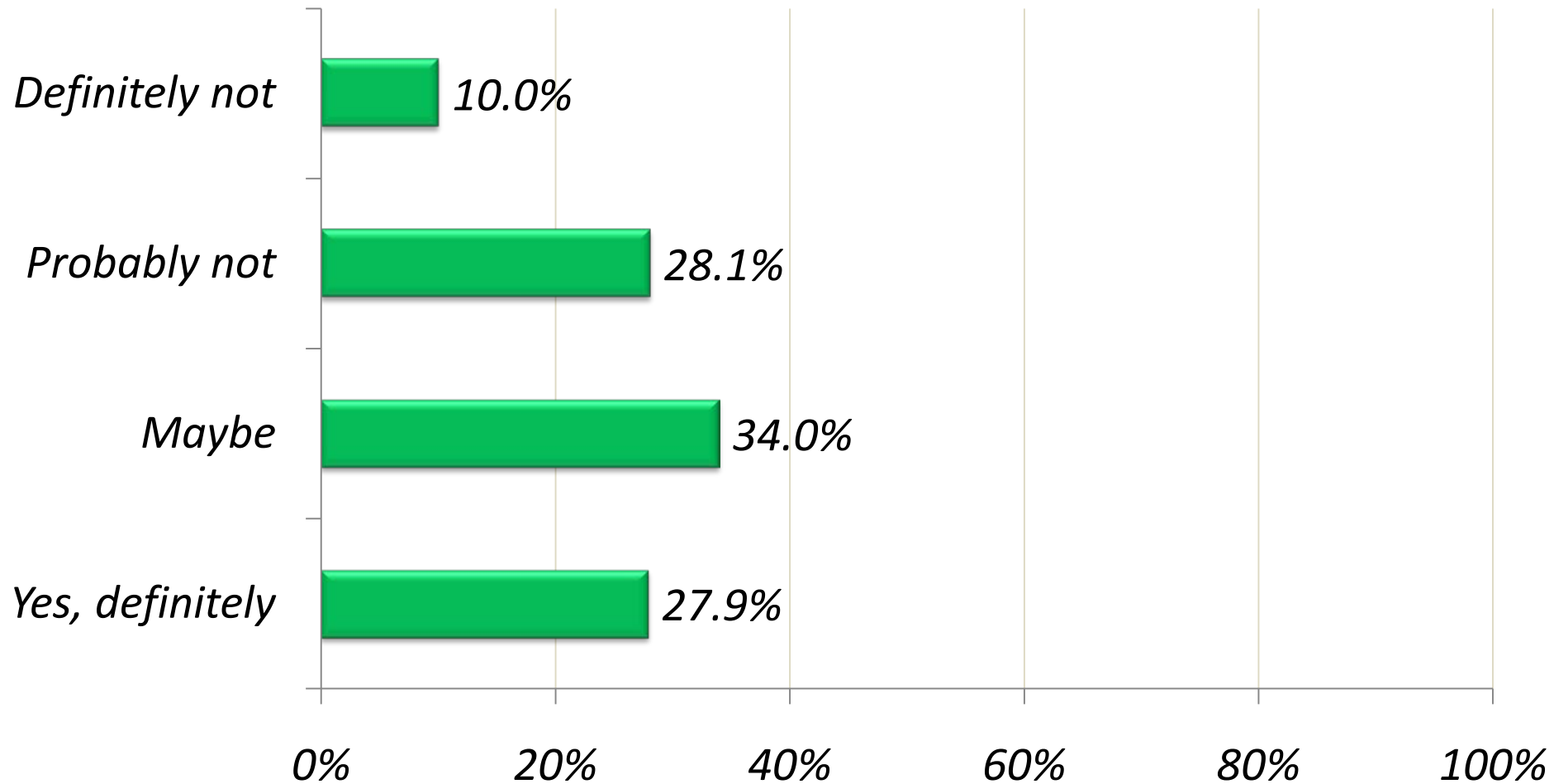

Possible Use of an Attended Recycling Center

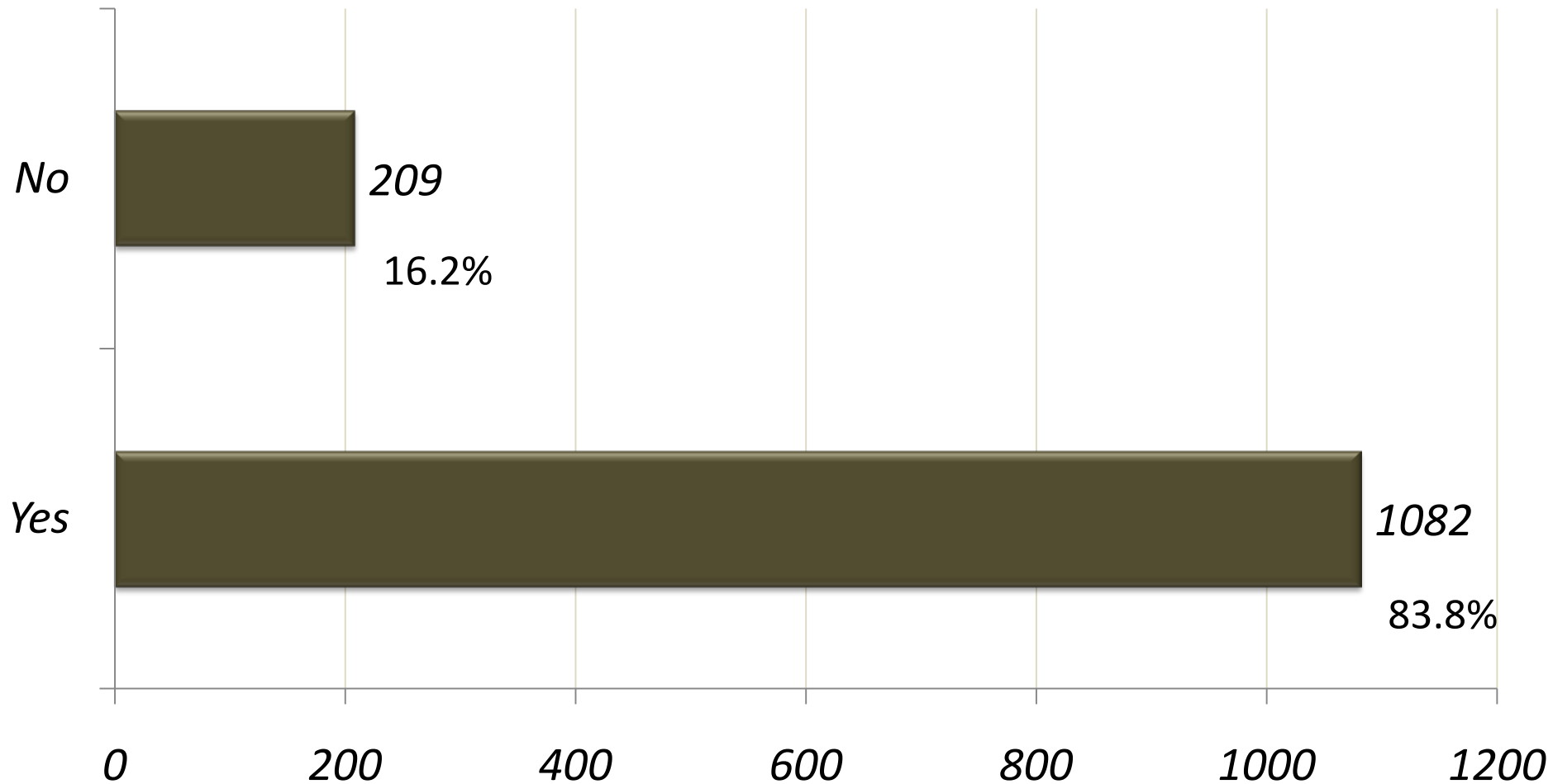

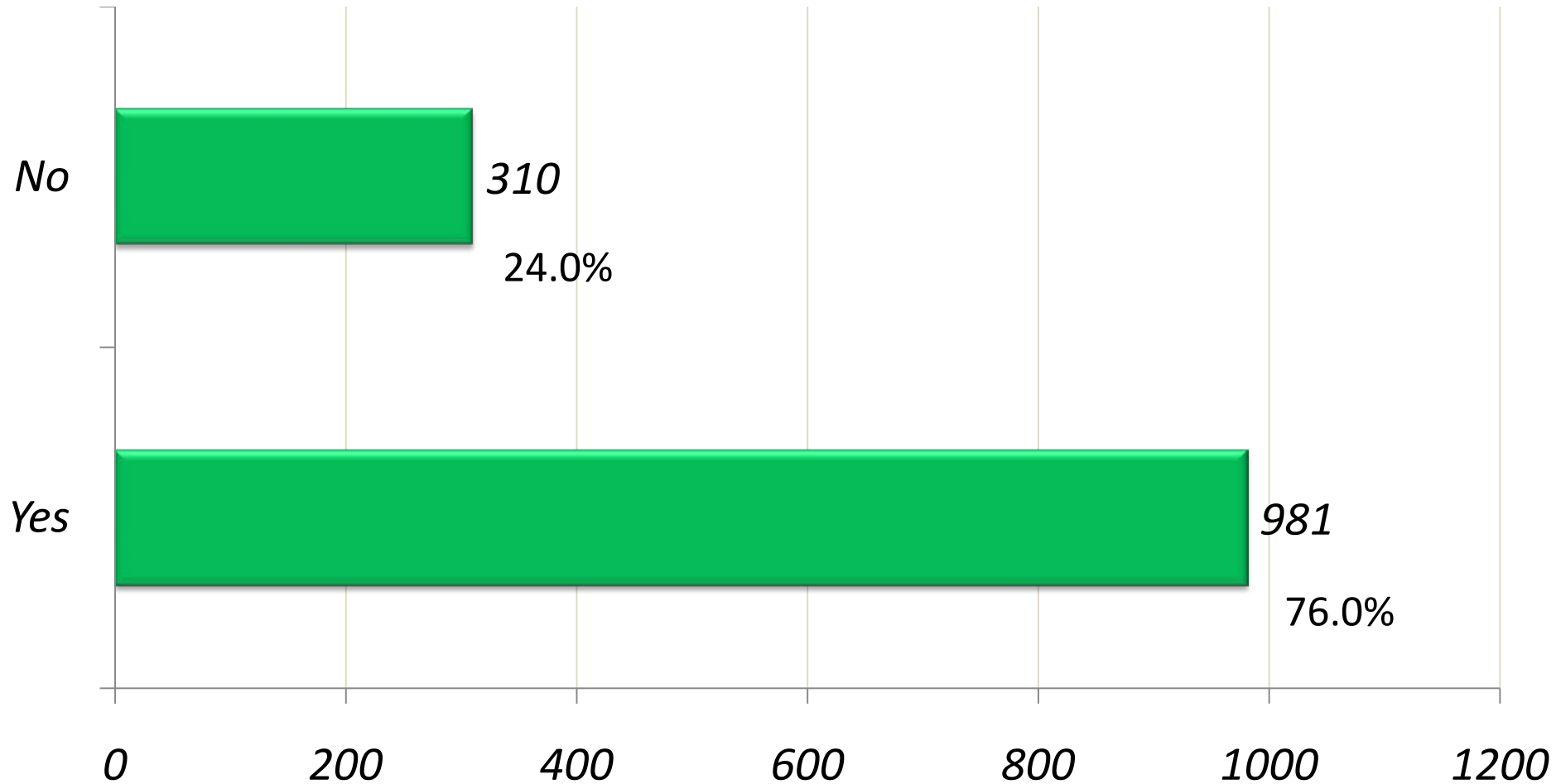

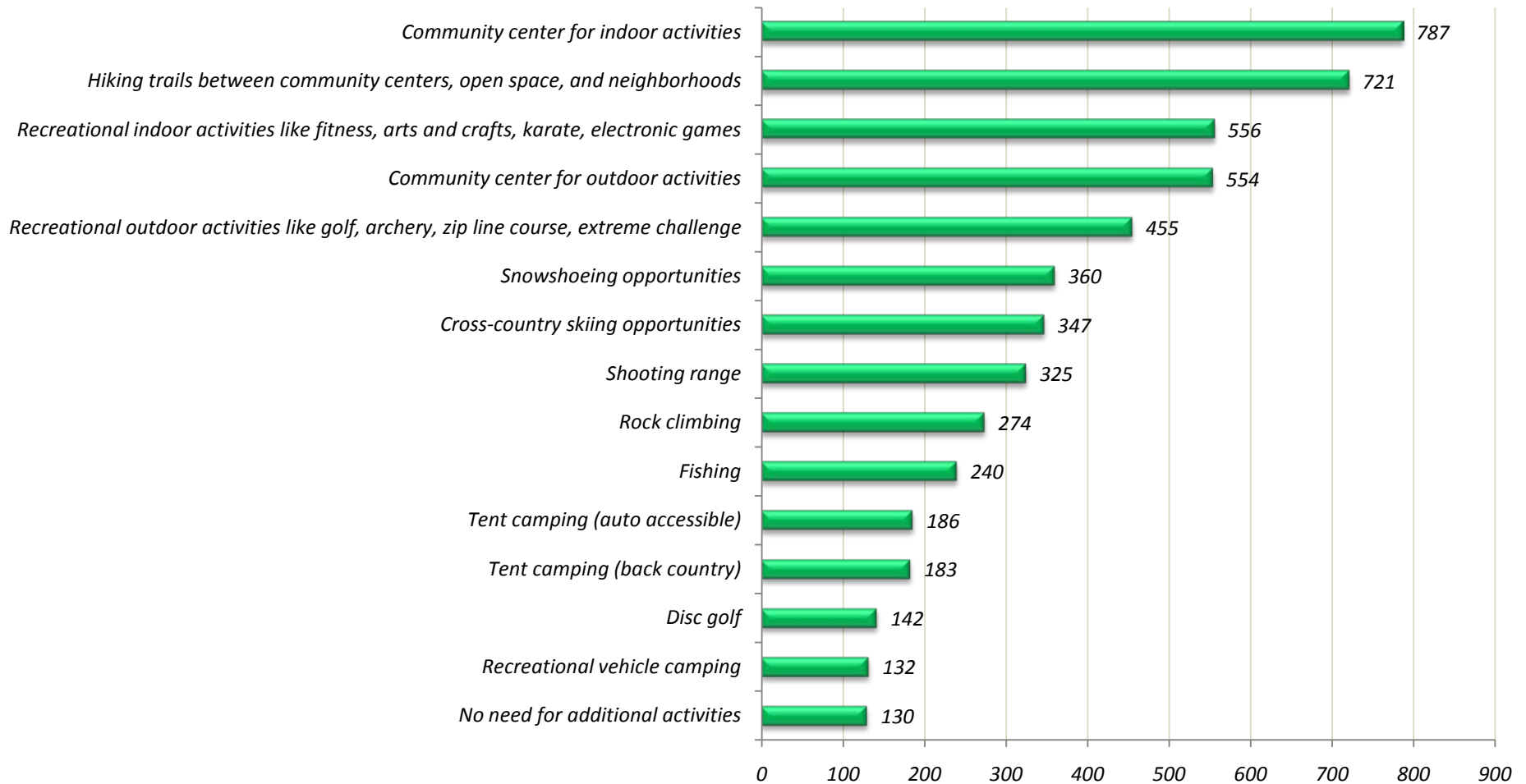

Recreational Activities Desired

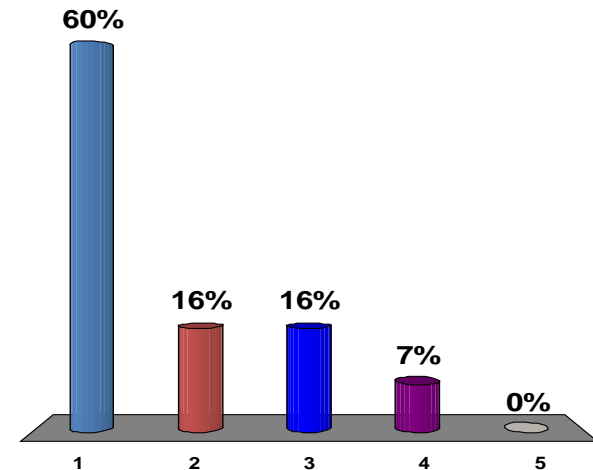

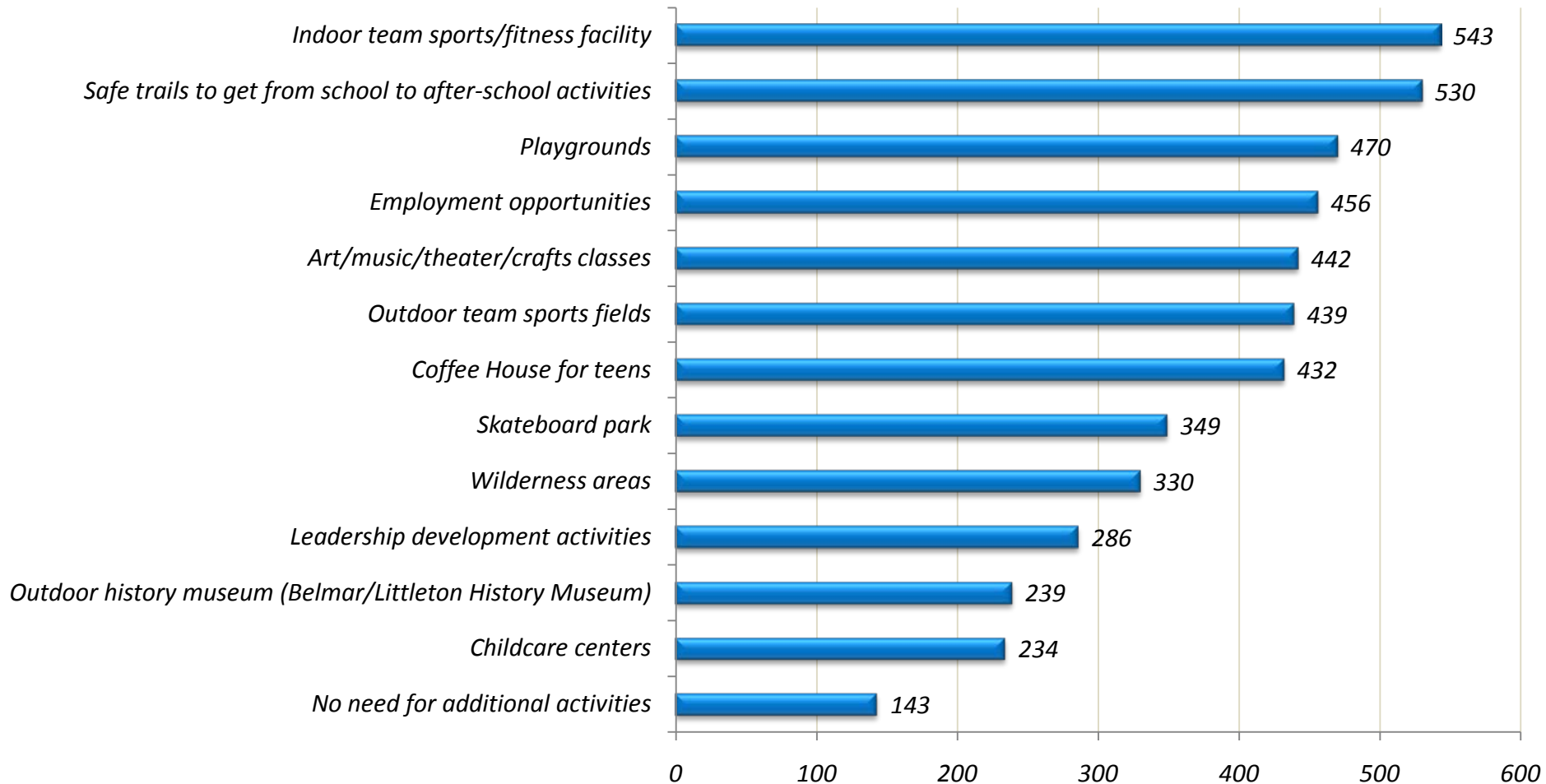

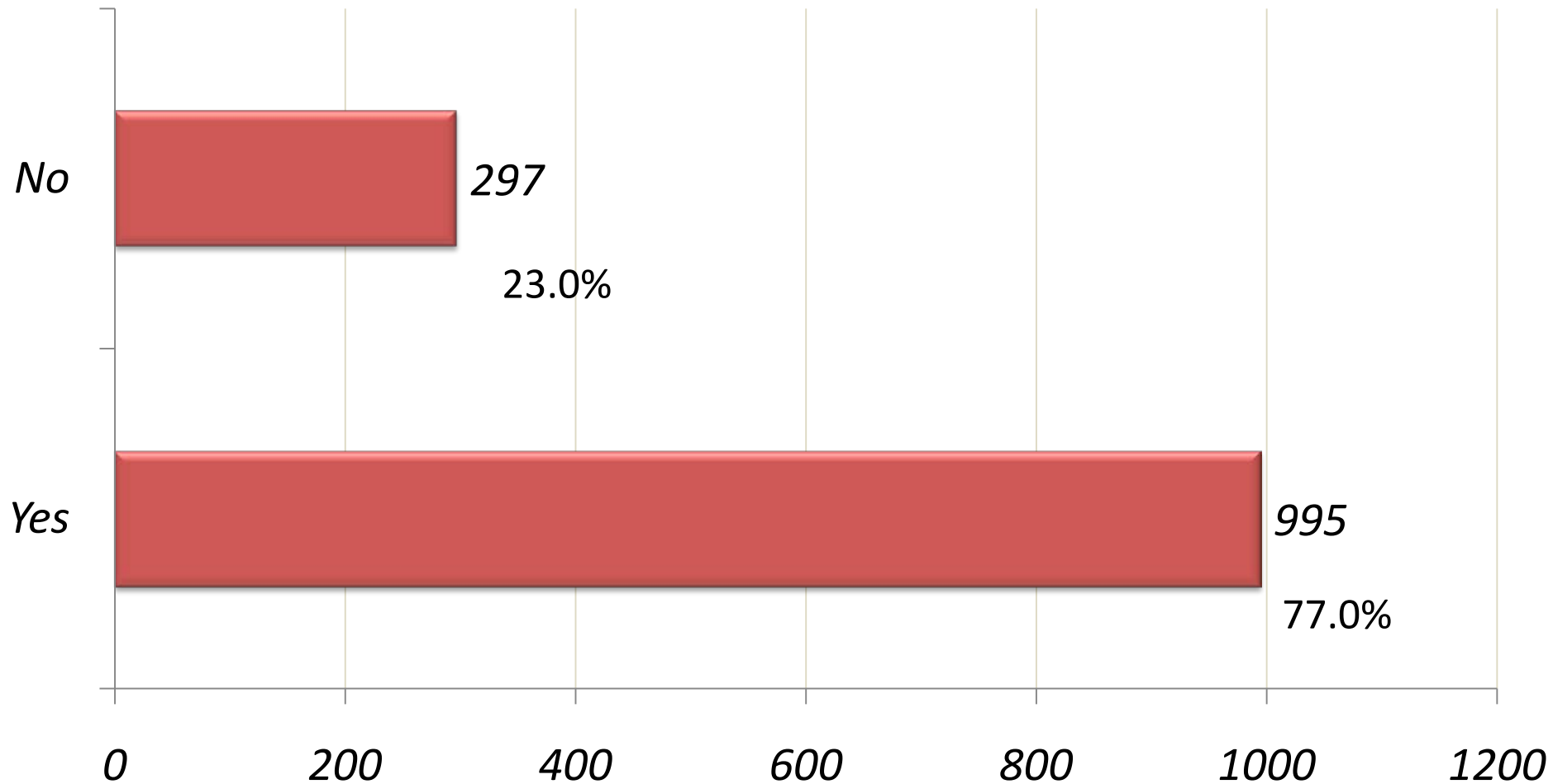

Doing Wildfire Mitigation

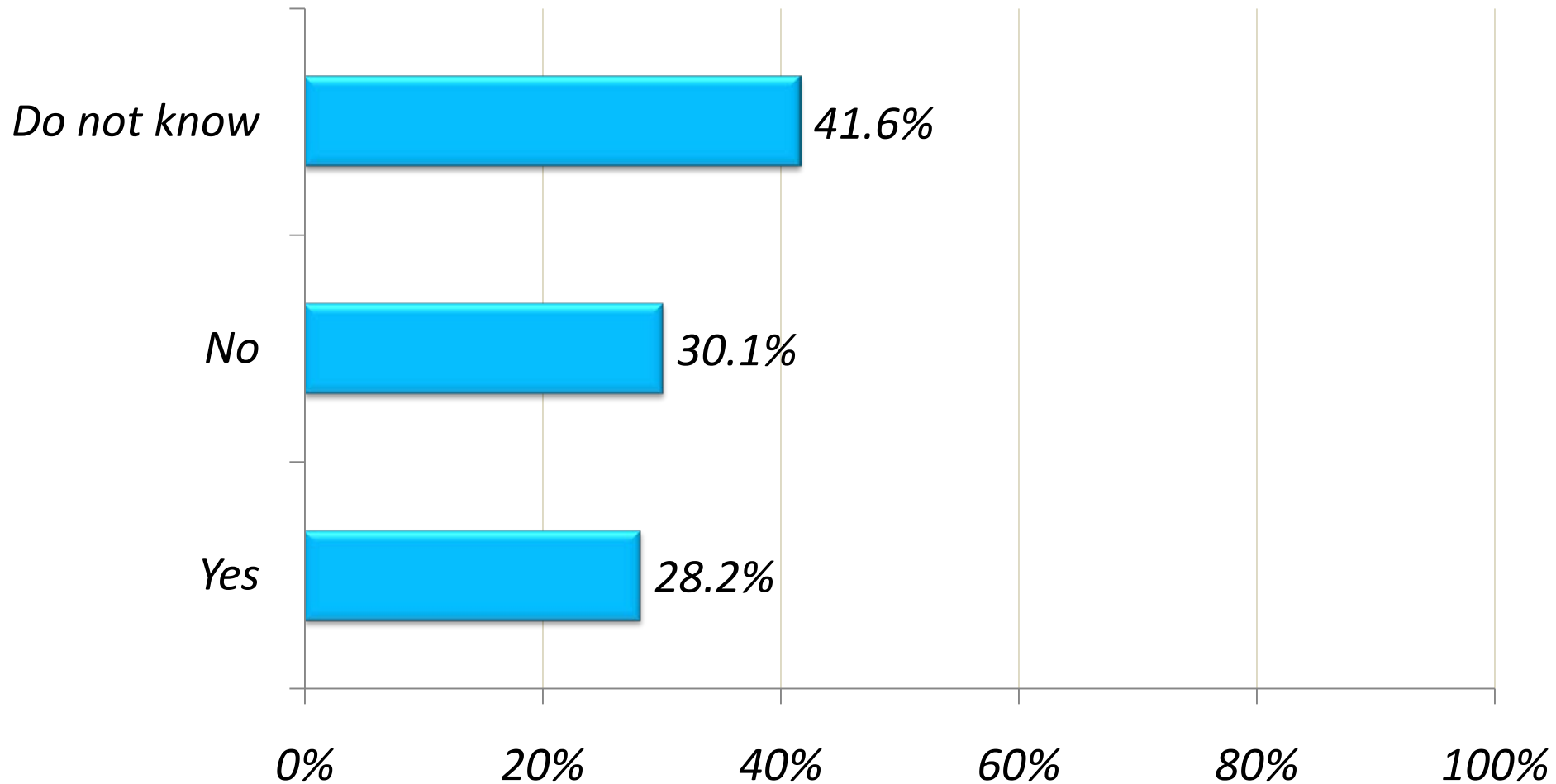

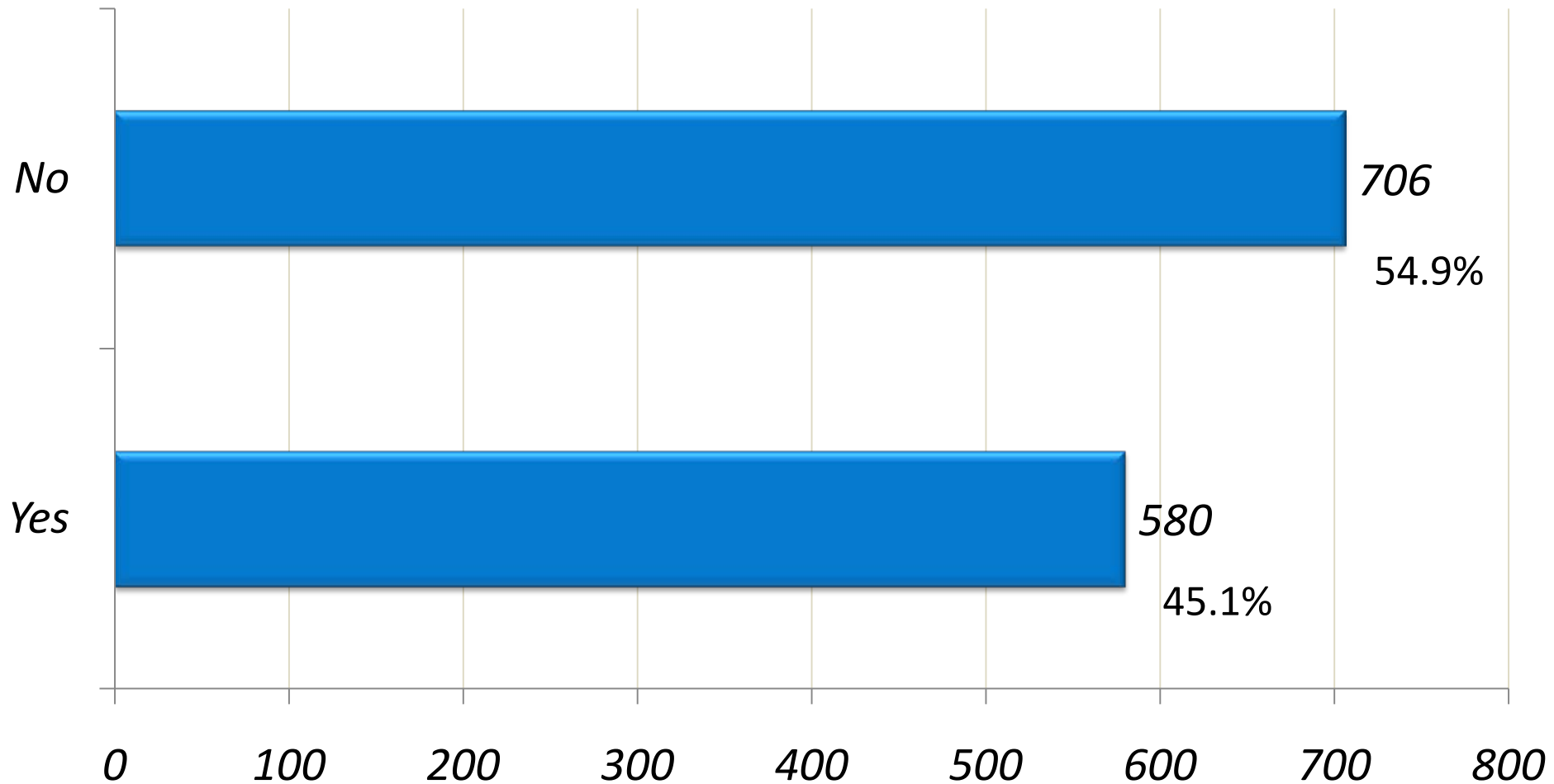

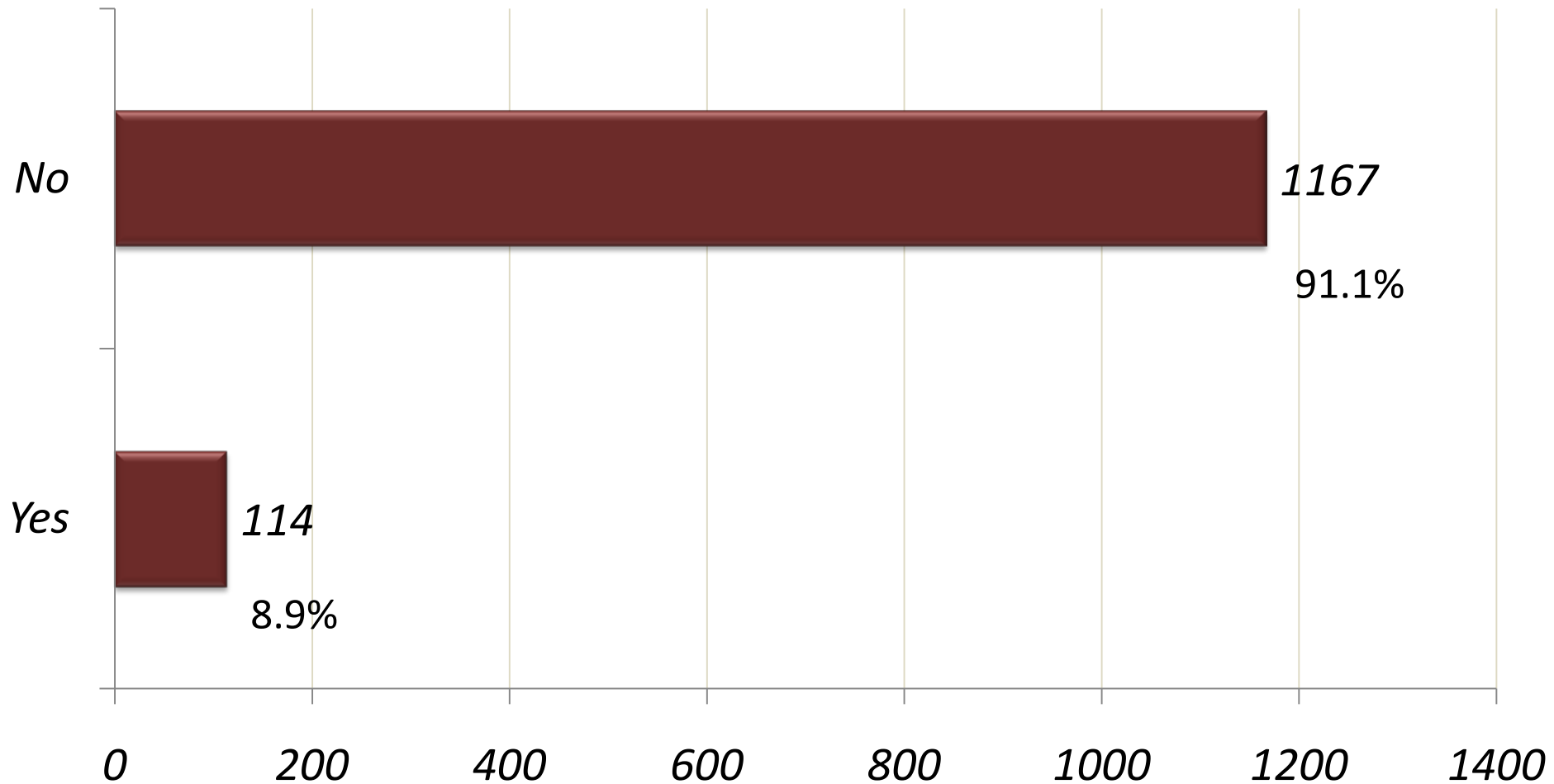

Property With Historic Significance

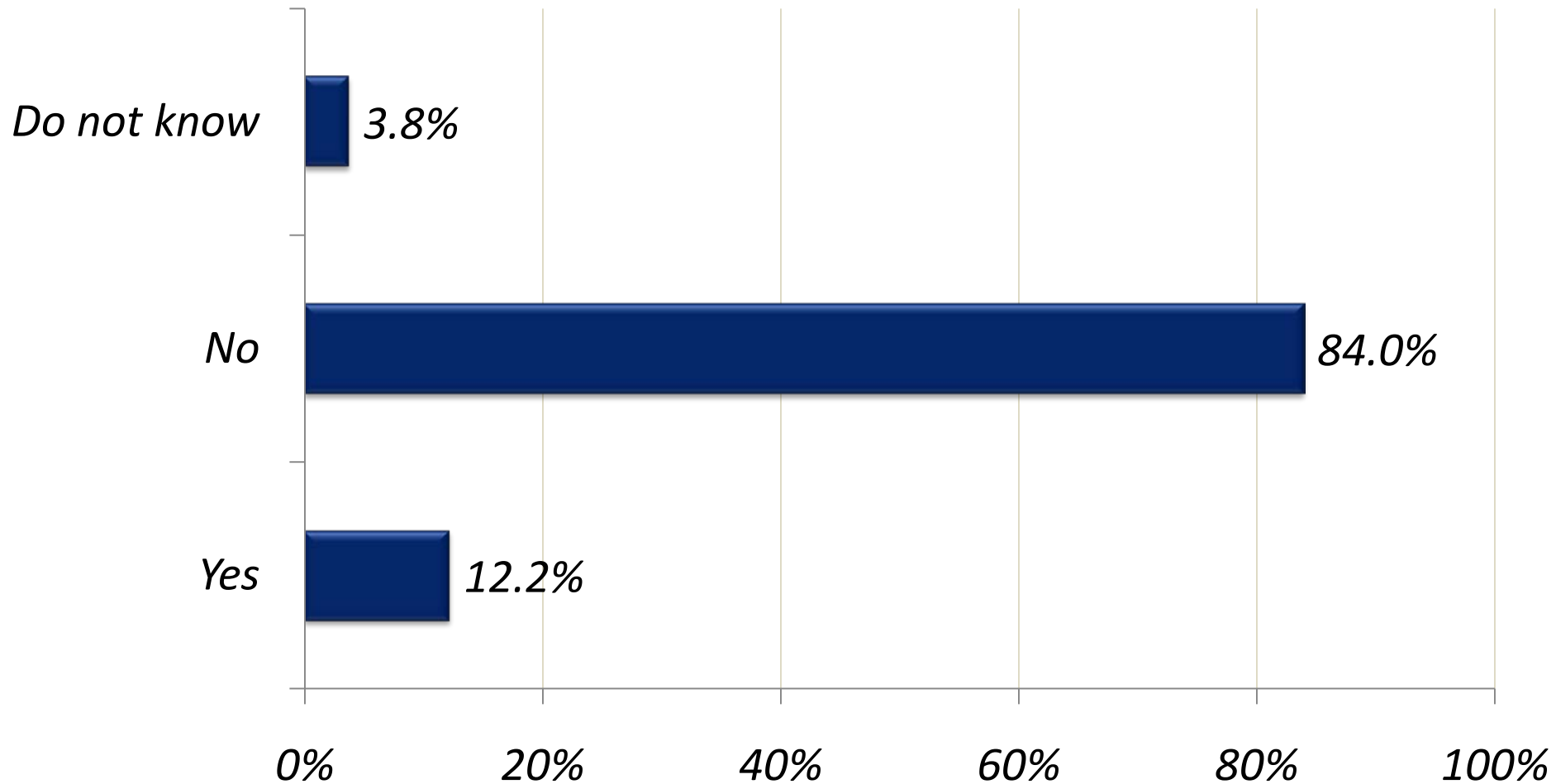

Property With a 50 Year Old Structure

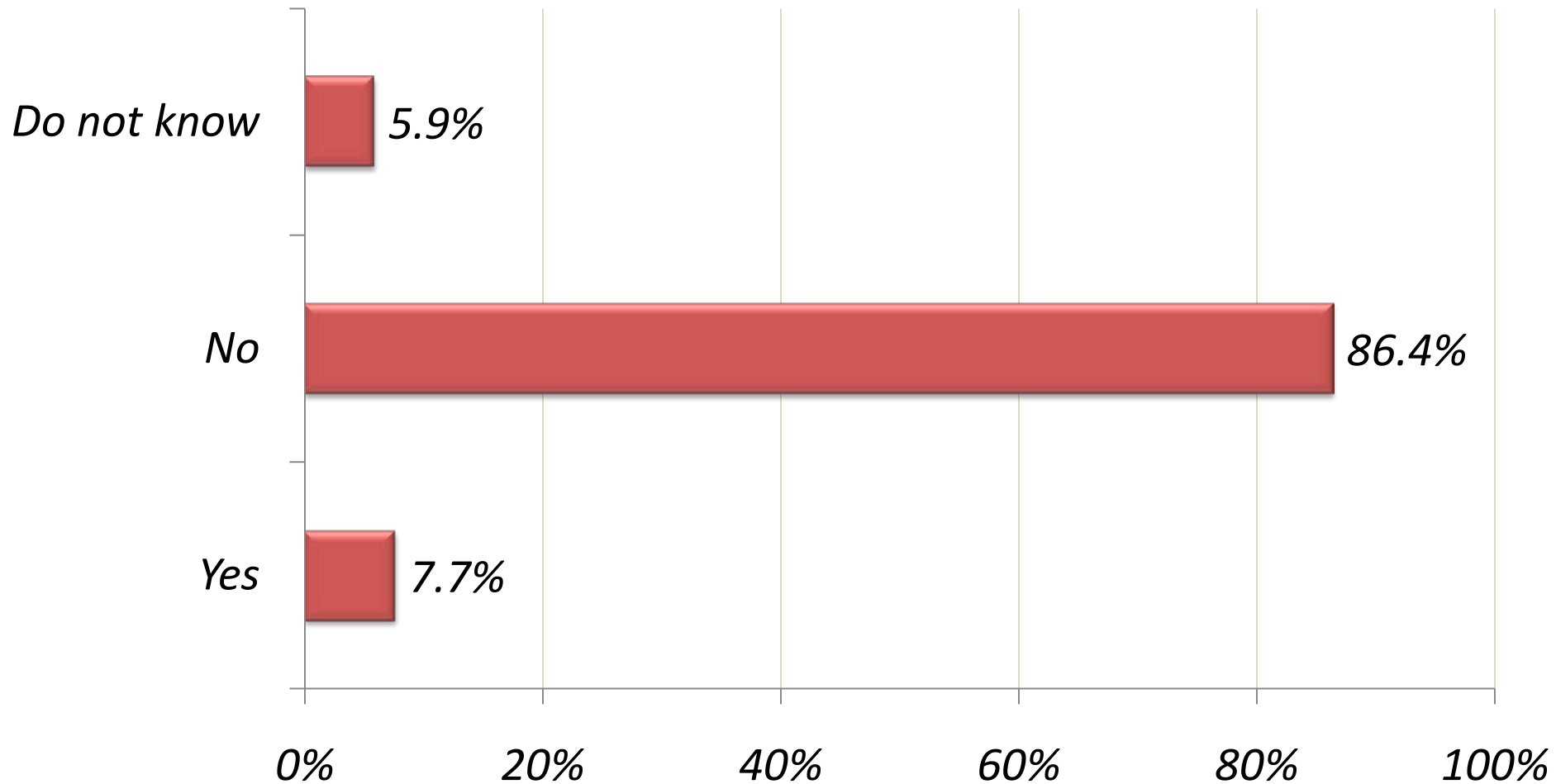

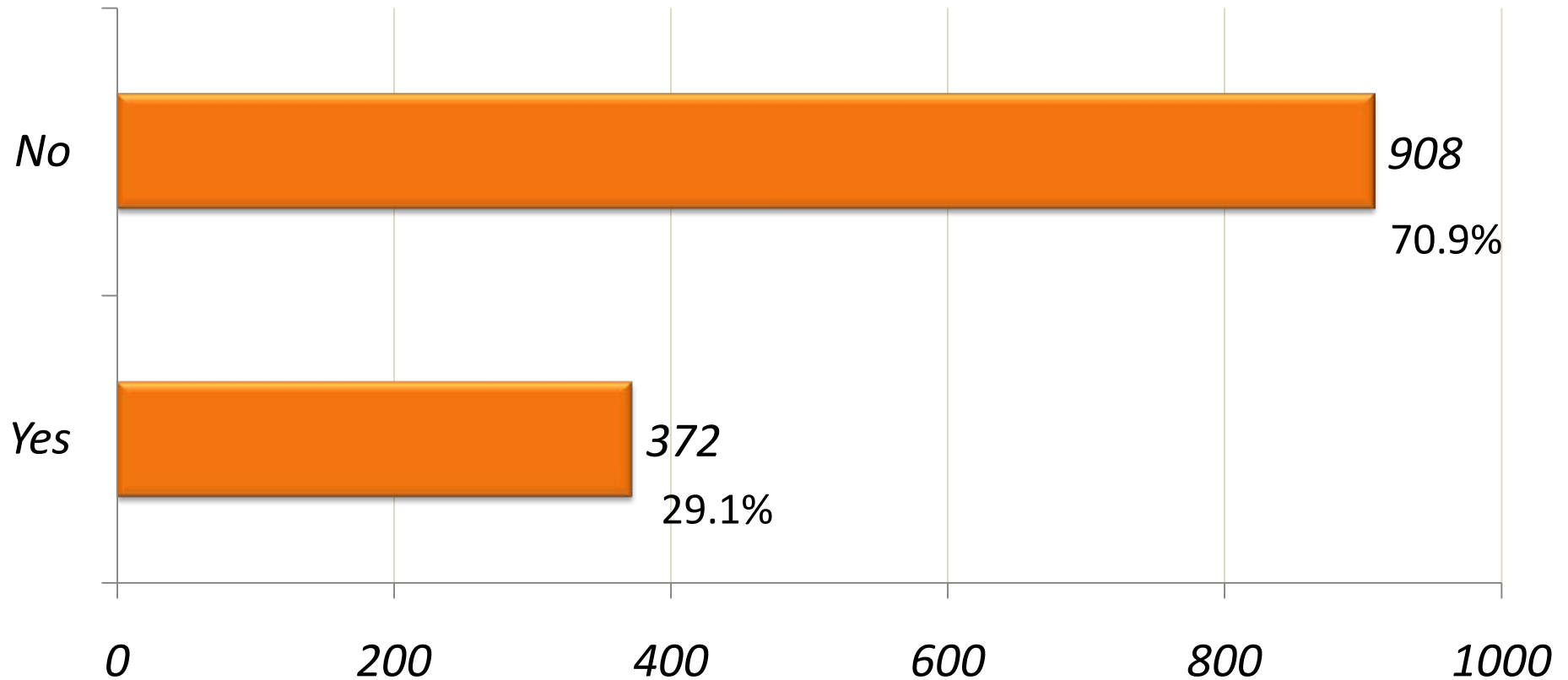

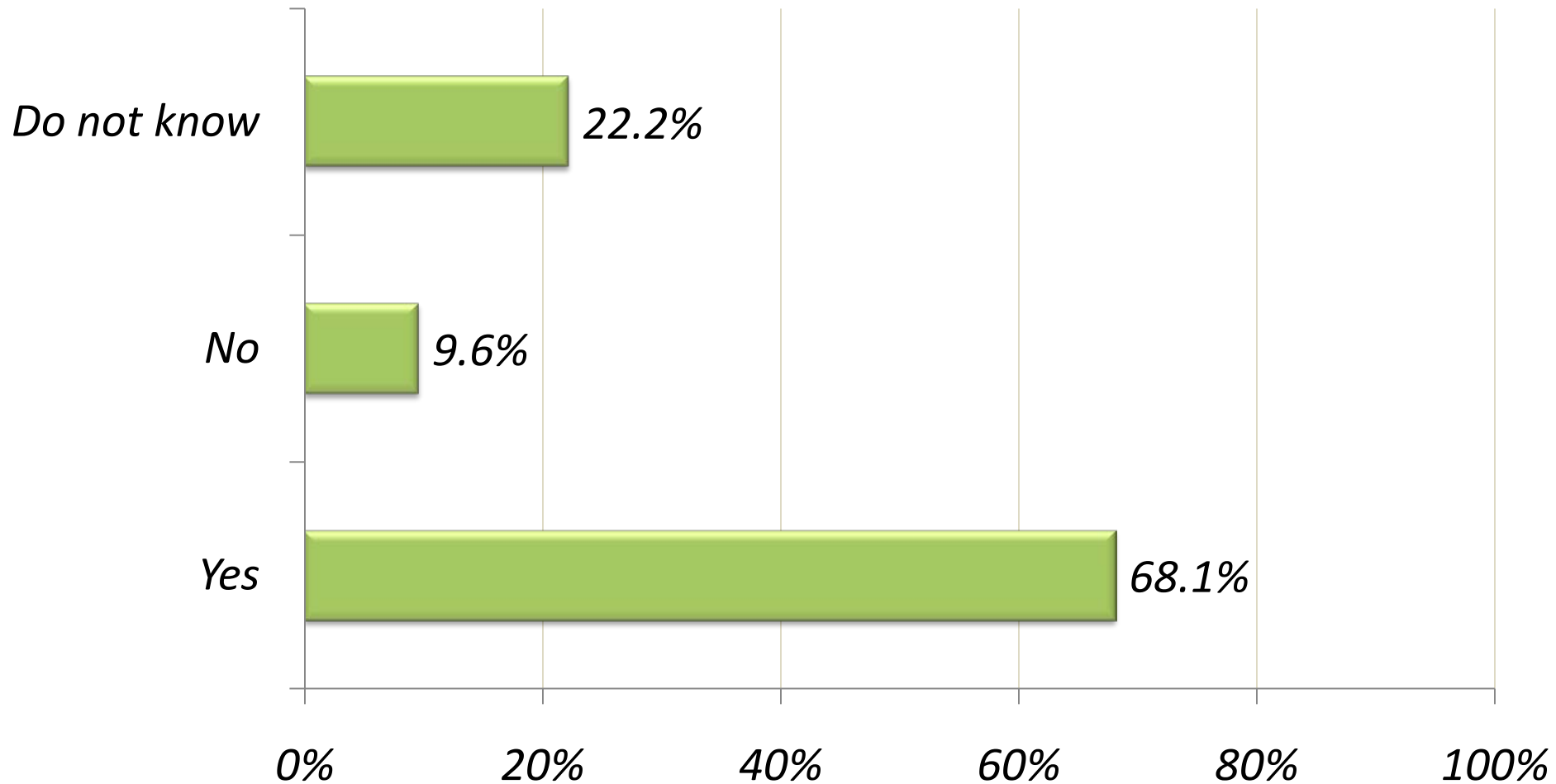

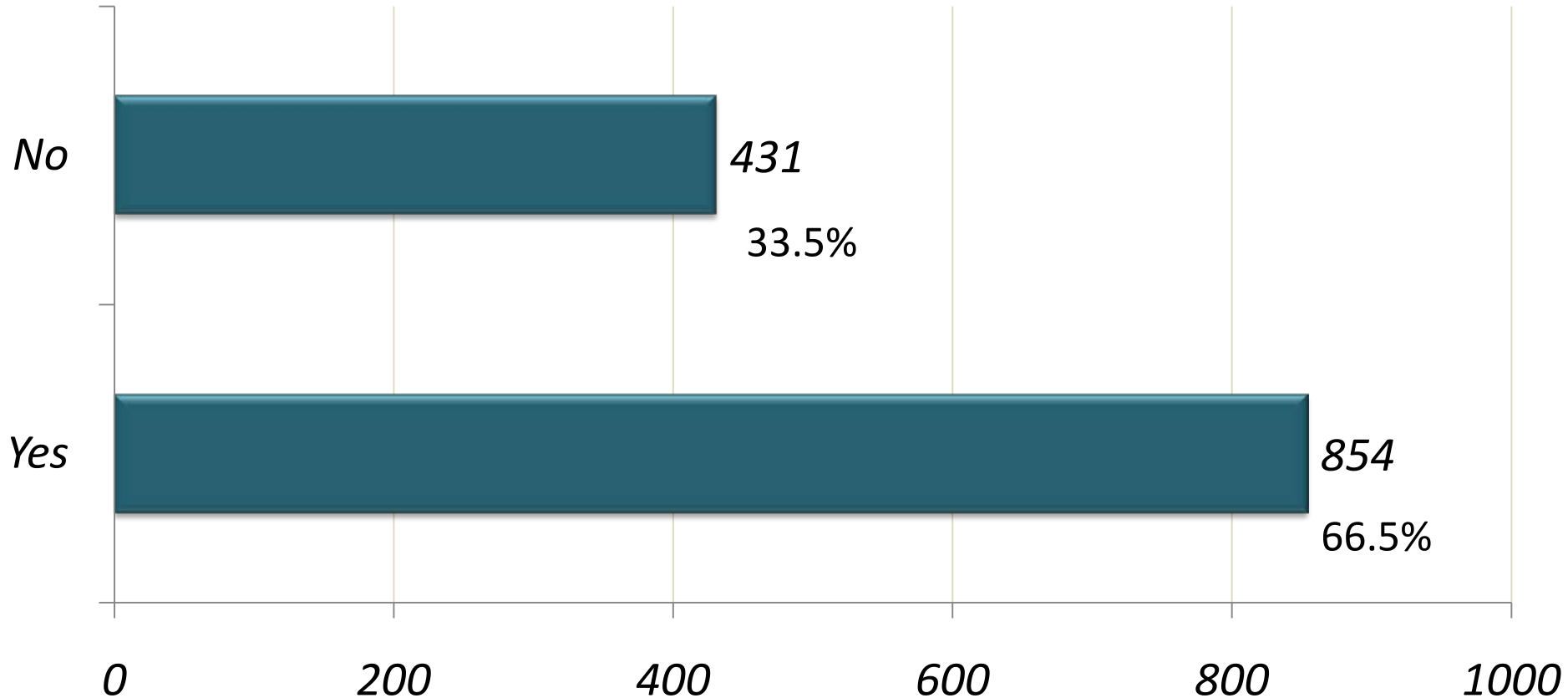

Awareness of Yellow Barn Preservation Efforts

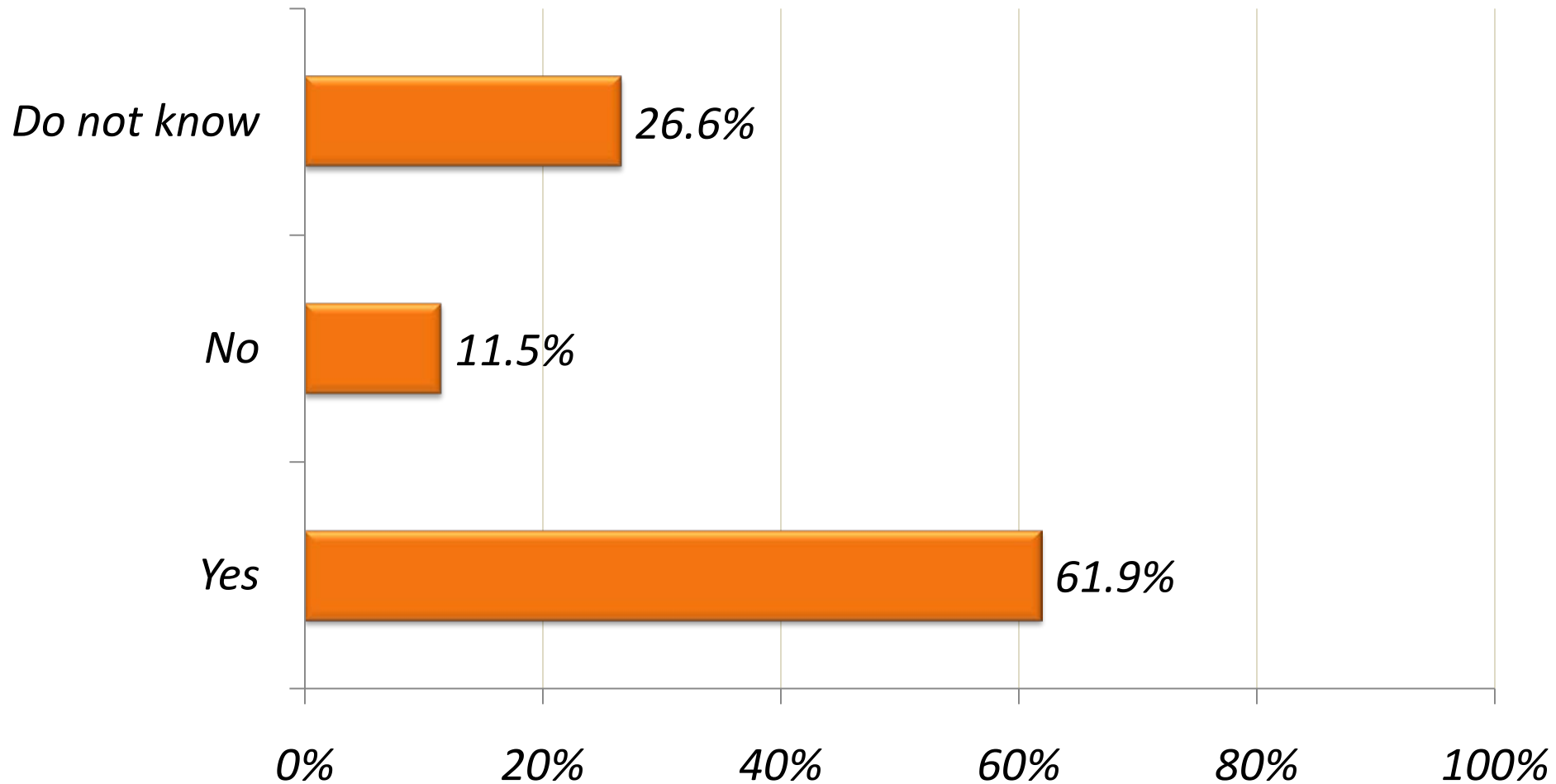

Would Support the Yellow Barn Preservation Effort

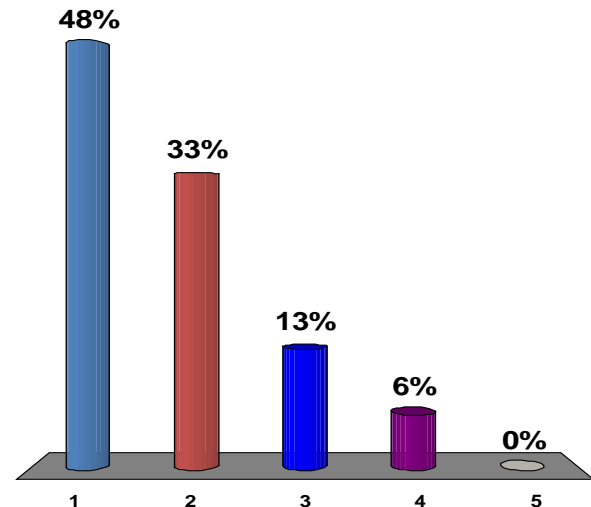




Conifer Community Survey— Town Hall Meeting Poll

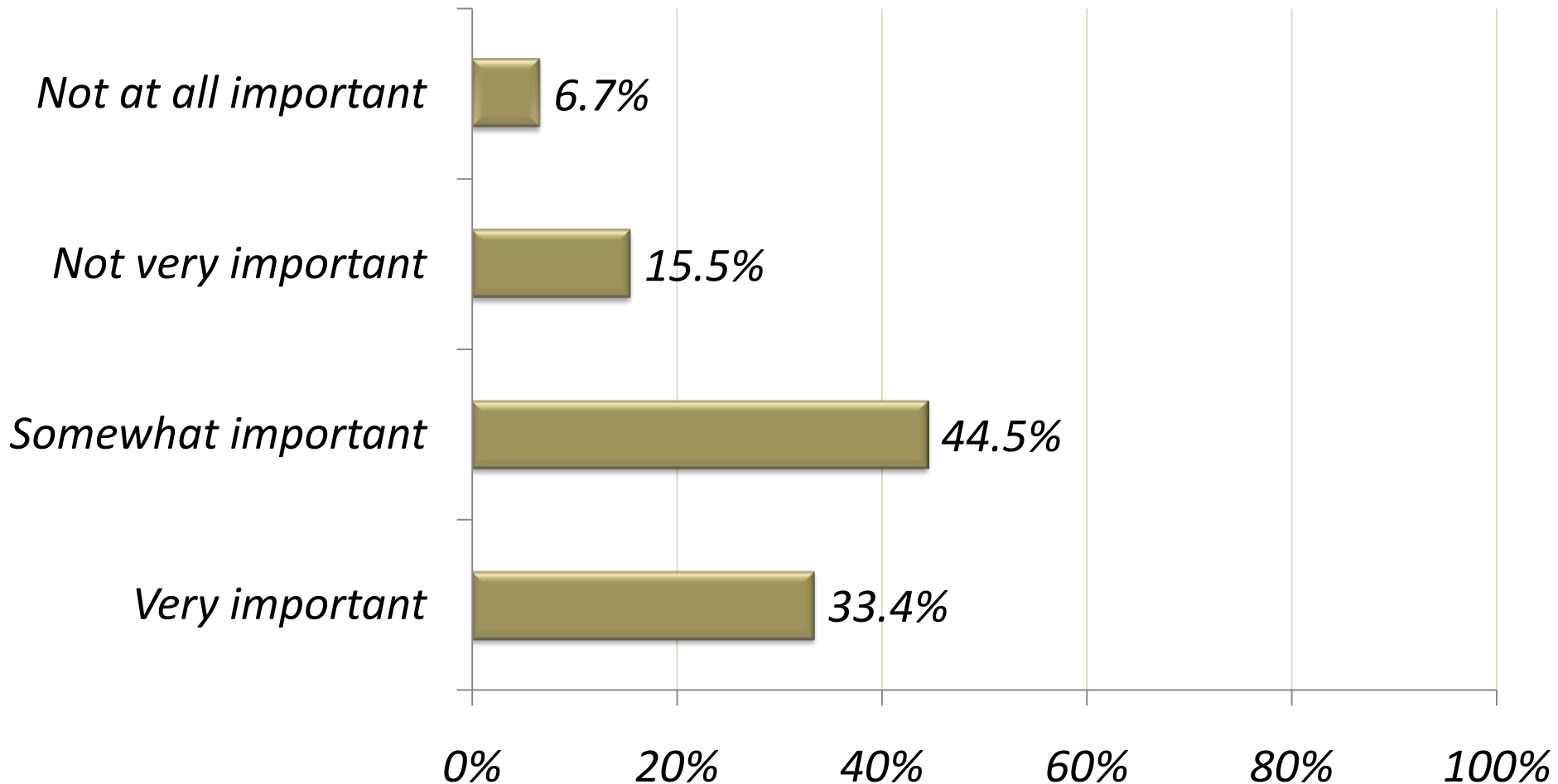

Importance of a Coordinated Wildflower Planting Program

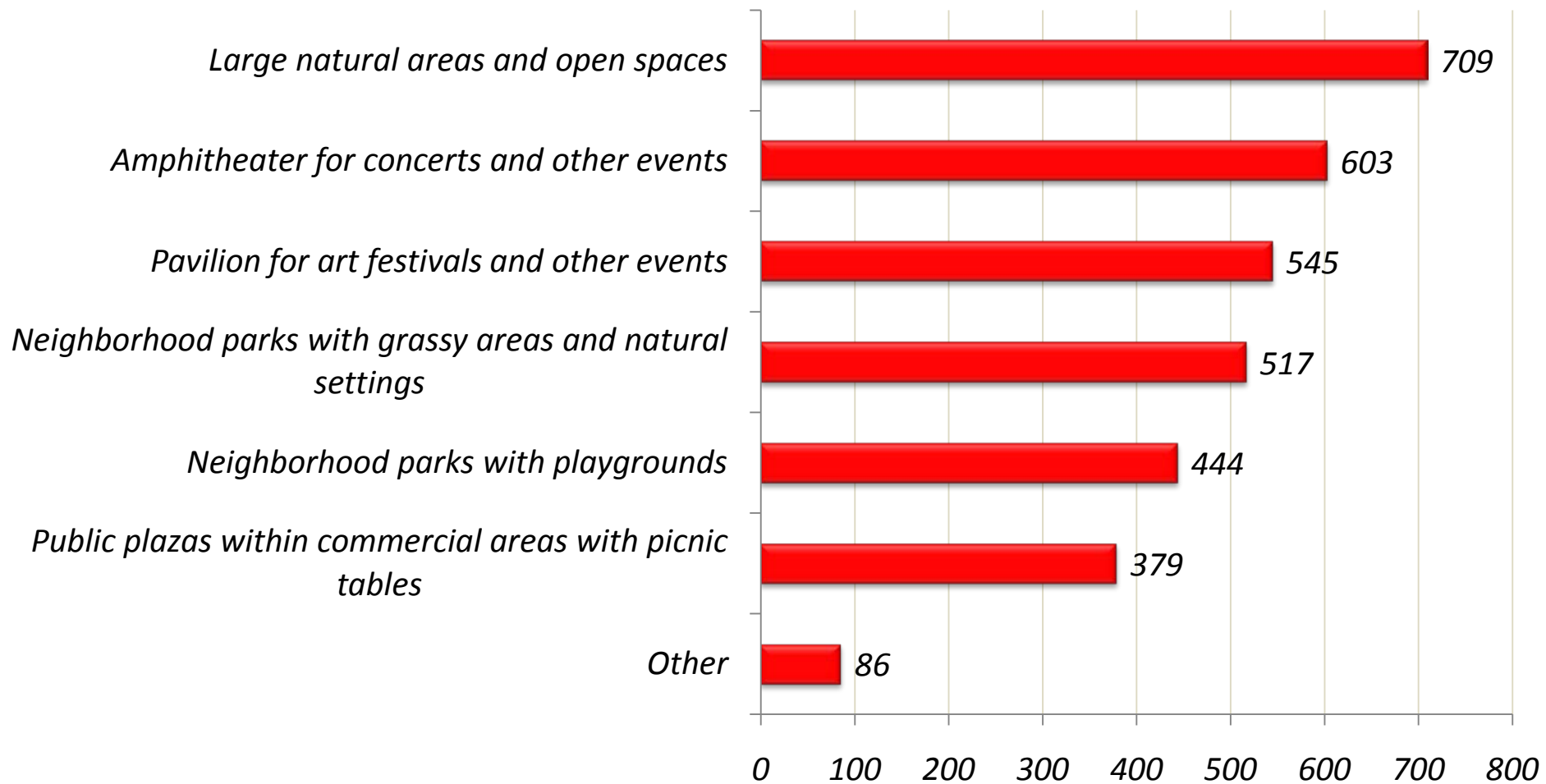

Preferred Gathering Places

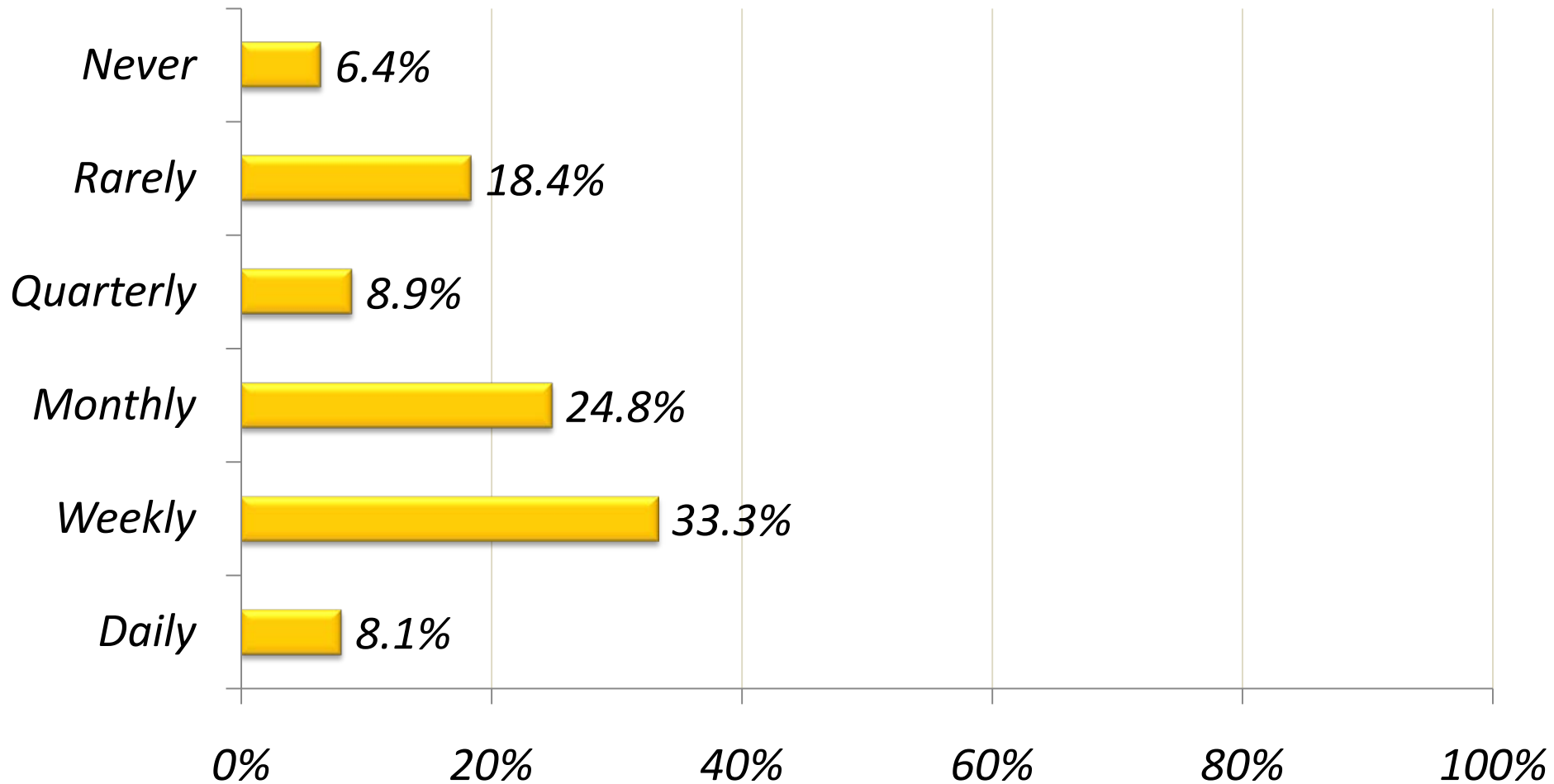

Use of Community Parks in the Summer

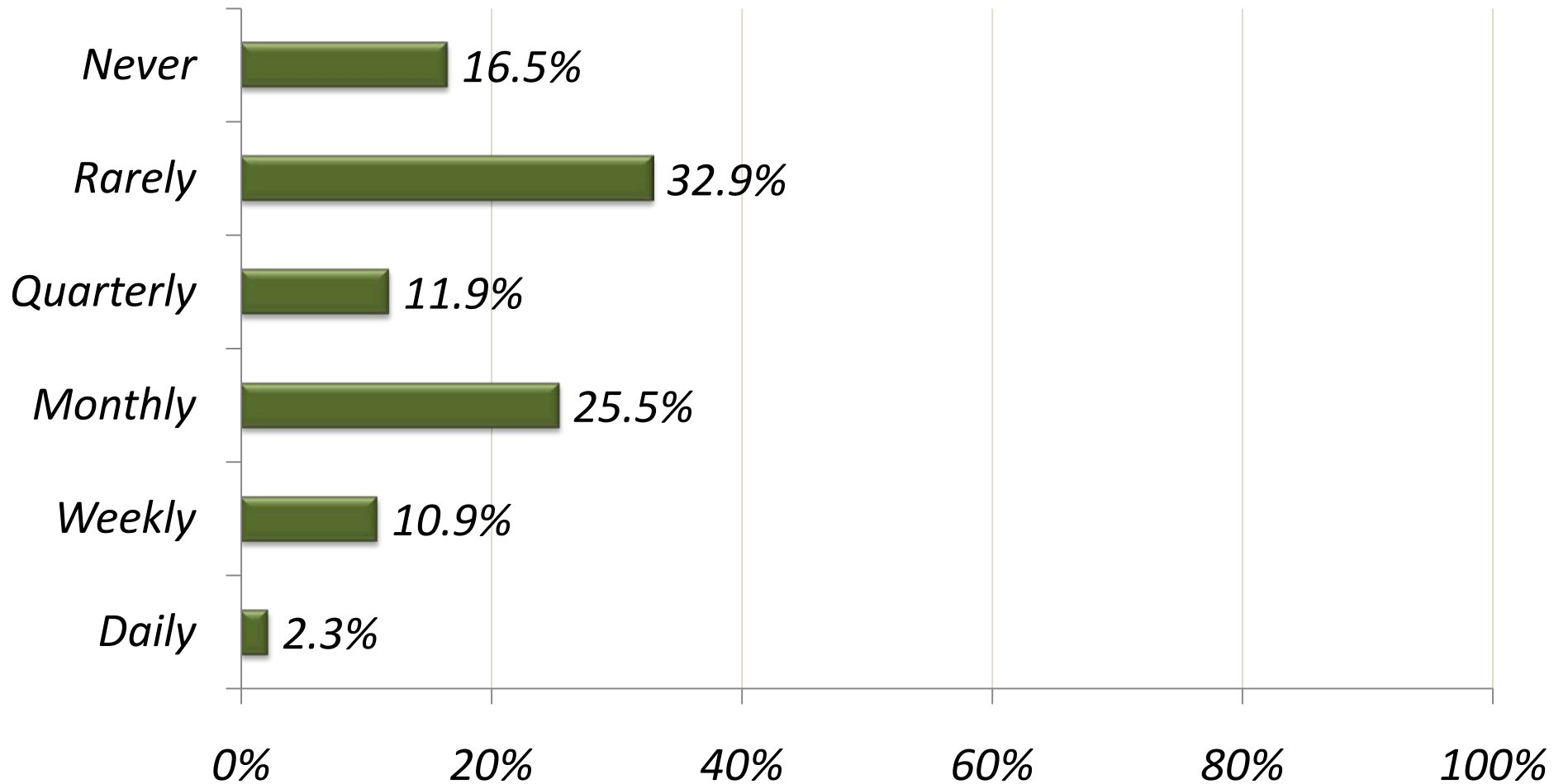

Use of Community Parks in the Winter

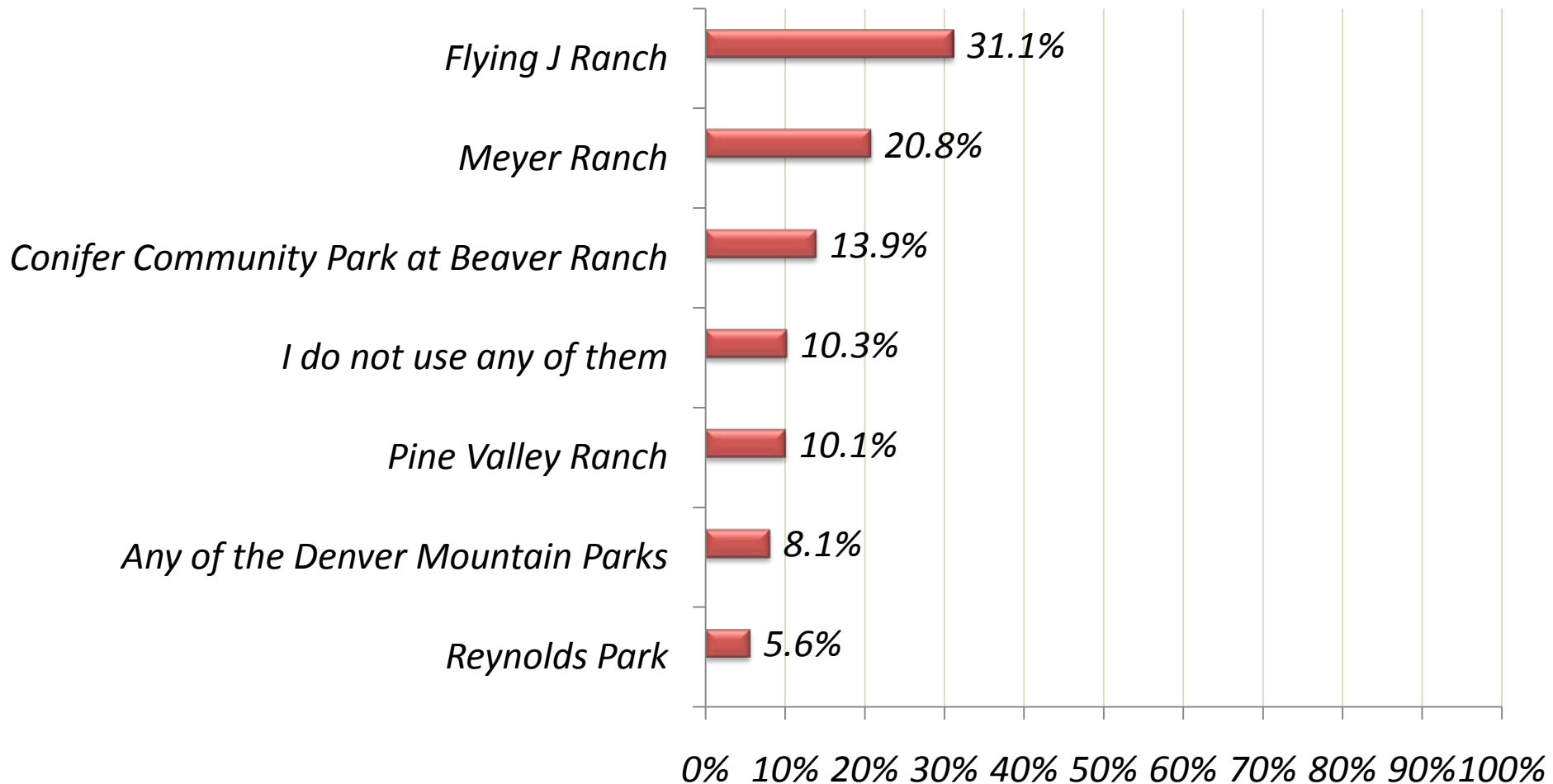

Most Used Community Parks

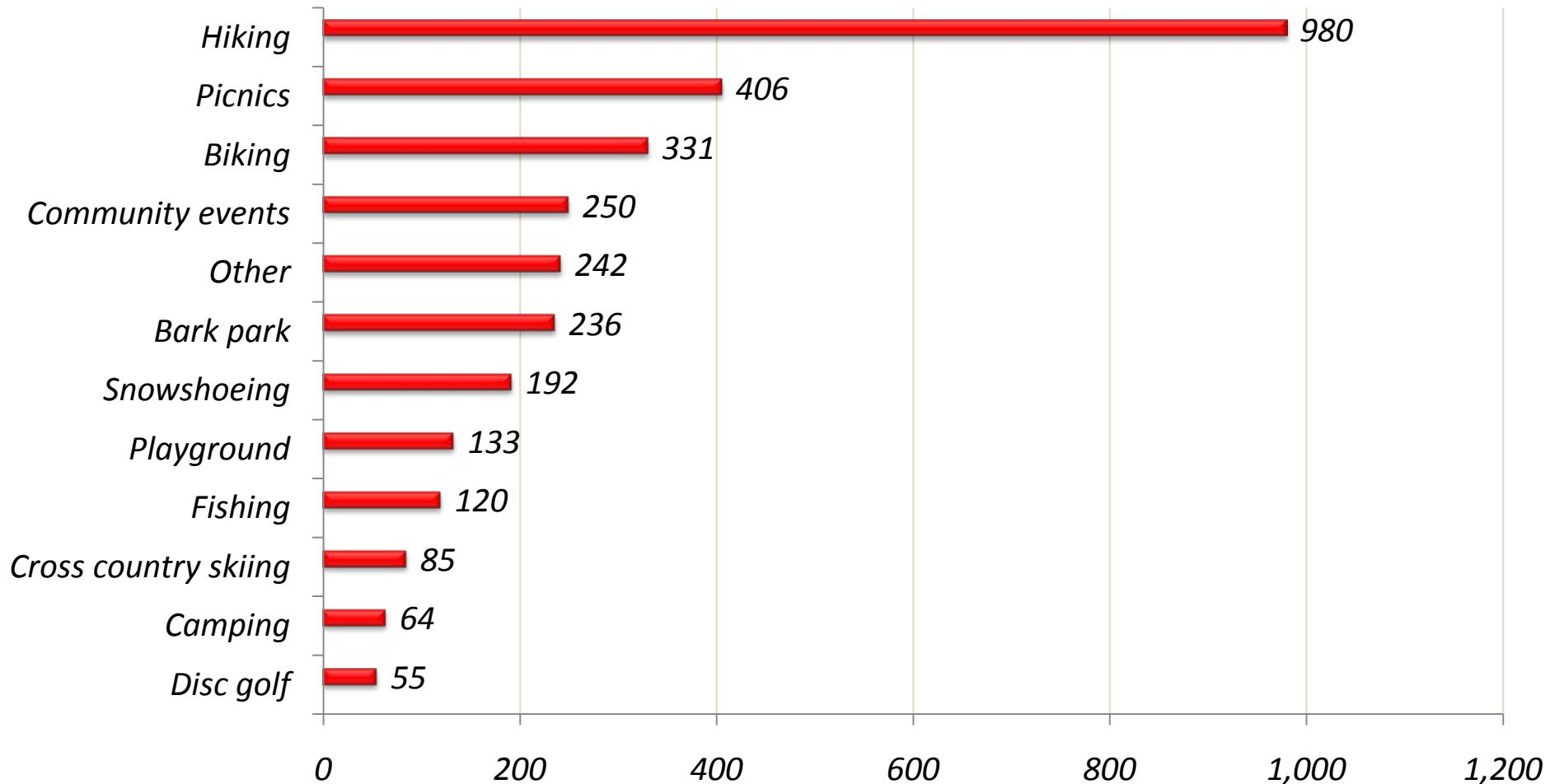

How Open Space Parks Are Used

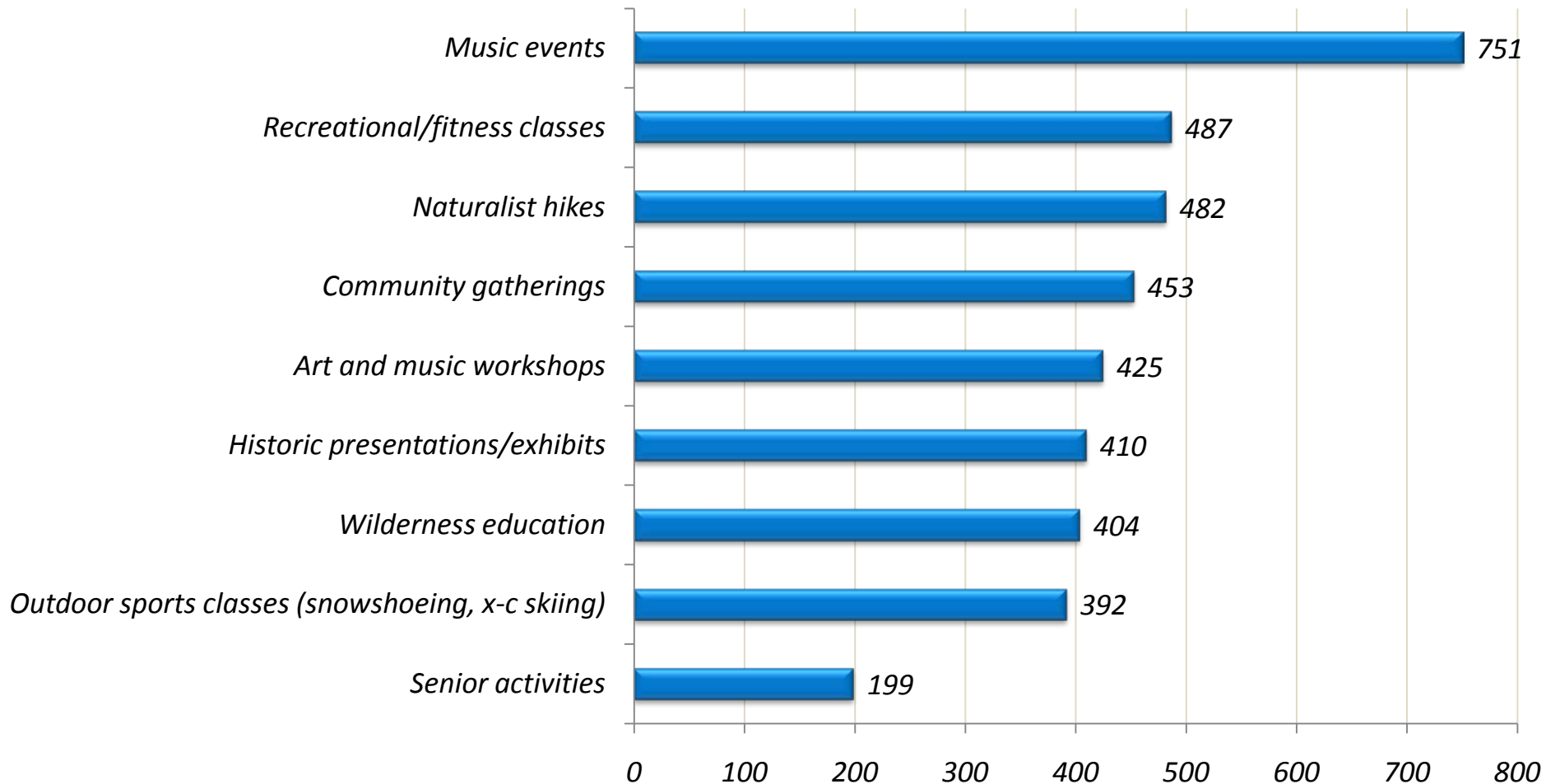

Interest in Additional Activities at Local Parks

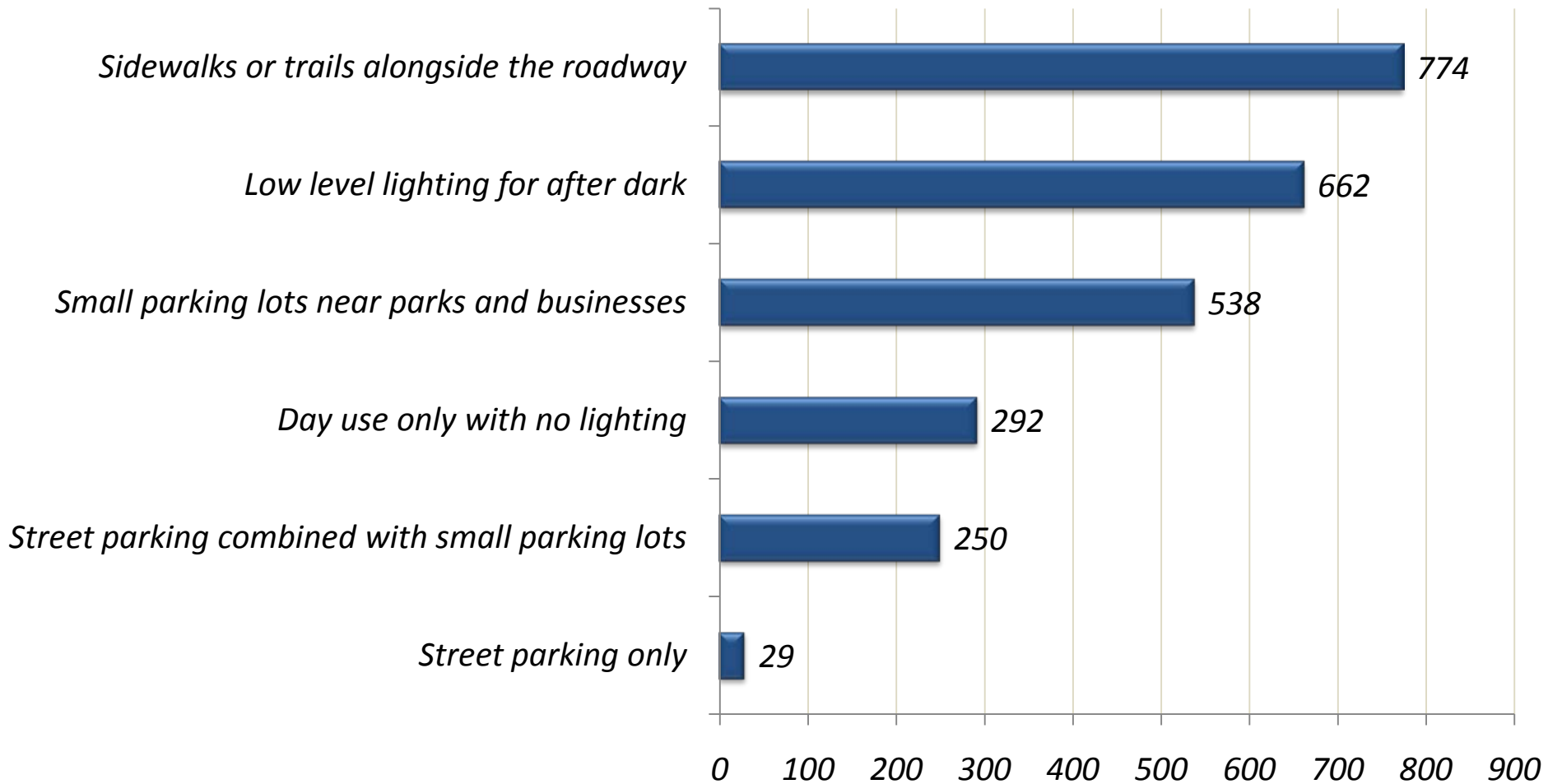

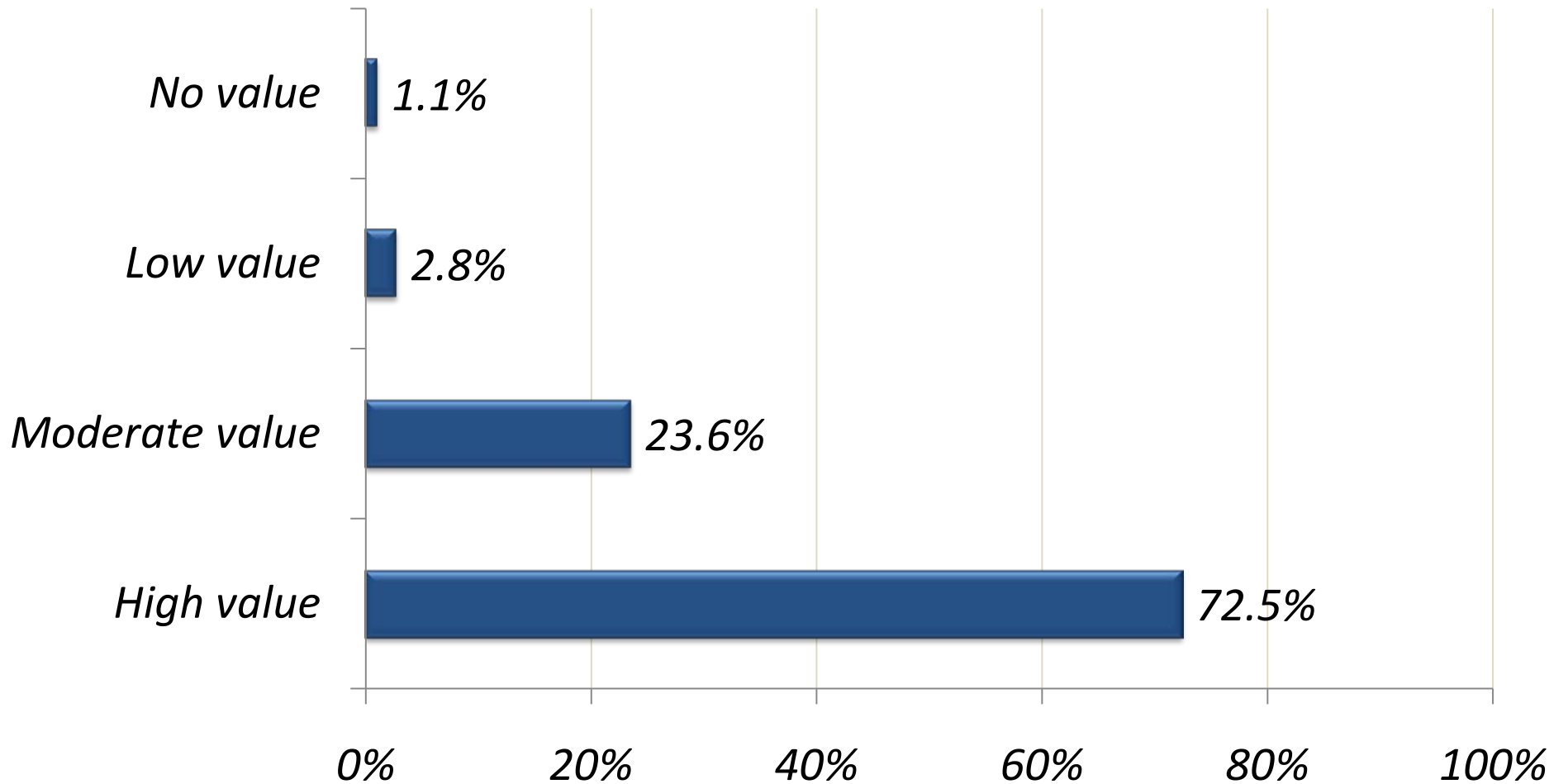

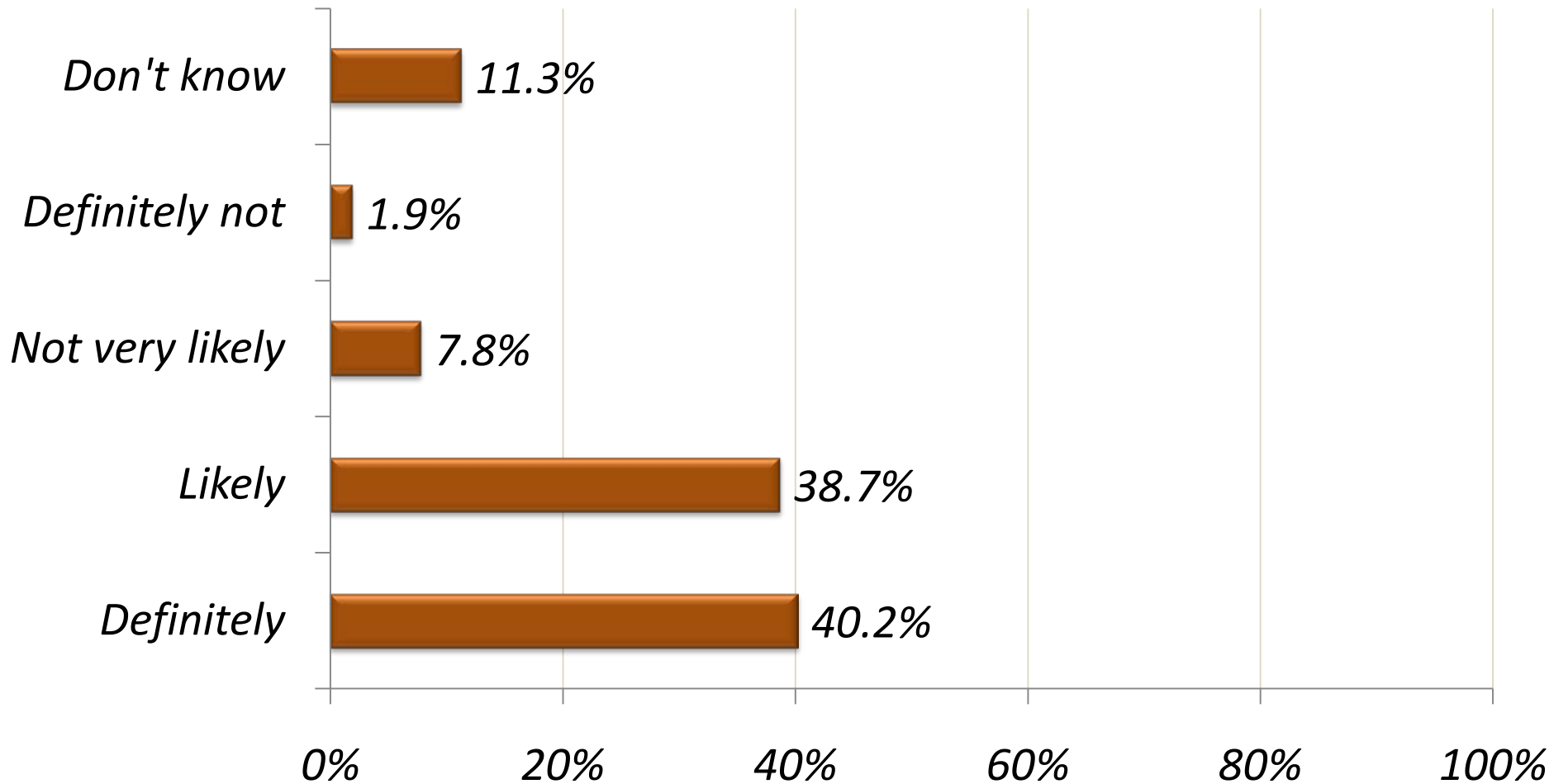

Awareness of the Conifer trails system development

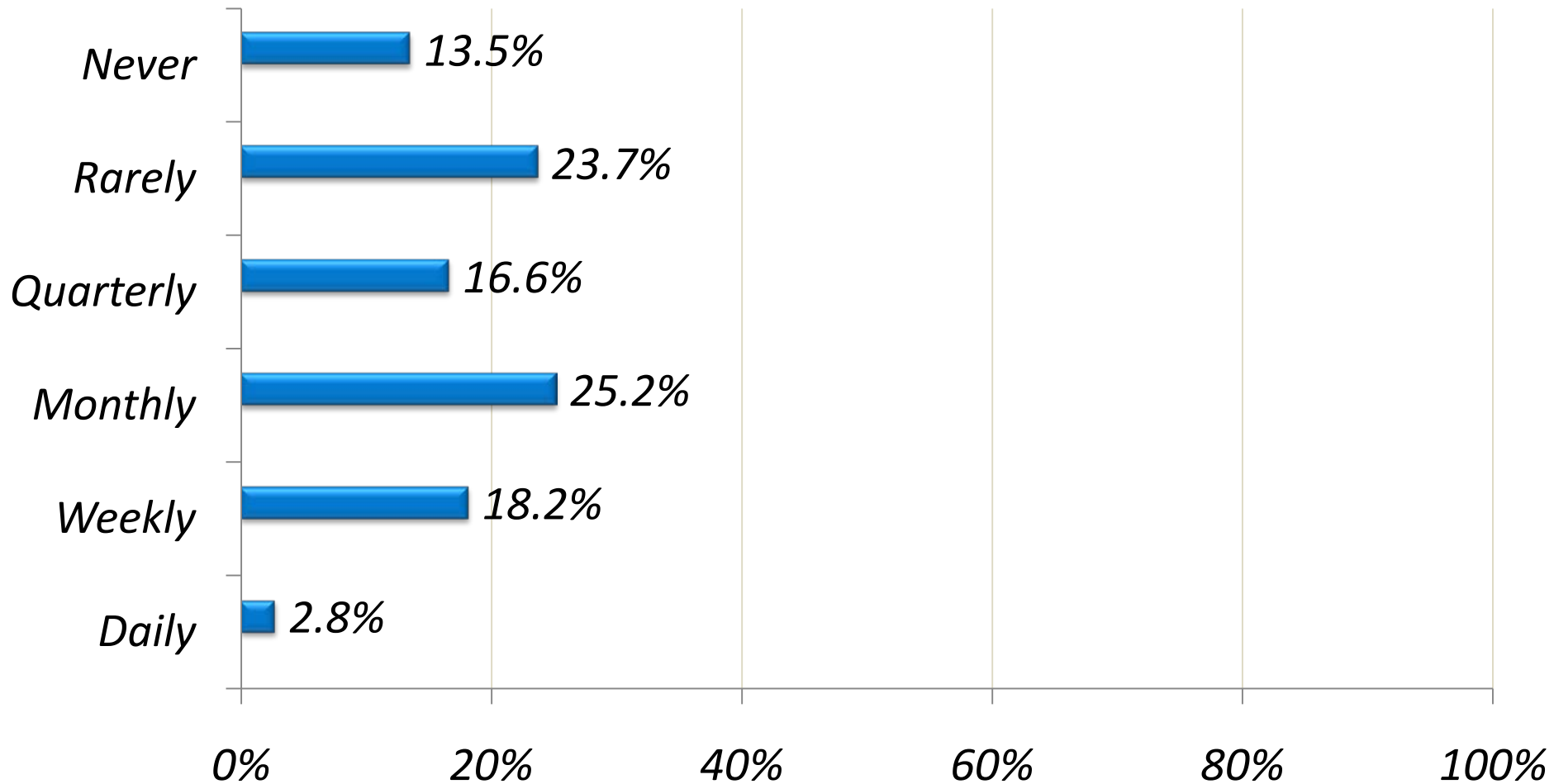

Frequency of Use of Other Denver Mountain Area Trails

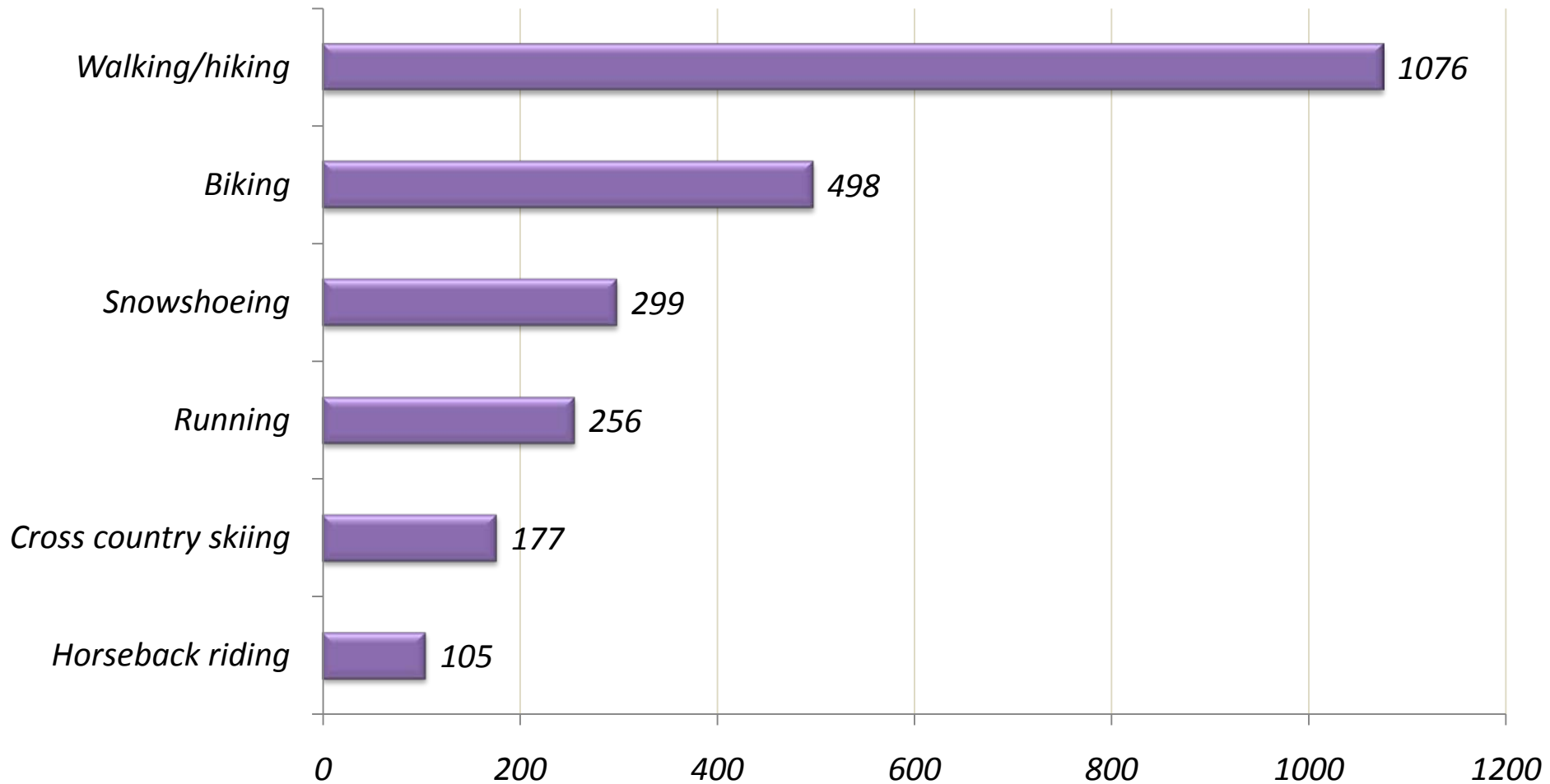
