






What is your gender?




Length of residency in the Conifer area? 685 responses






















How would you rate the Conifer area community related to quality and safety? Check all that apply 671 responses
















Rate the clarity of your water, on a scale from 1 to 5 with 5 being clear and 1 being poor. 676 responses




Rate the taste of your well water with 5 being very good and 1 being poor.




Rate how adequate your water is to meet your needs with 5 being totally adequate and 1 being inadequate.




Rank how important you think water supply is to our community well-being with 5 being high and 1 being low.










VILLAGE CENTER OPTIONS


Currently, we have the CONIFER / ASPEN PARK VILLAGE CENTER, which includes the Safeway, Kings Soopers and Staples commercial areas, and the PINE JUNCTION VILLAGE CENTER, where more commercial and higher density housing are allowed. When asked if there is a need for additional village centers, 83.10% of respondents in the 2014 Community Survey and 93.14% of the respondents in the 2018 Community Survey said that we don't need additional Village Centers. They thought current empty storefronts should be filled instead of building new commercial developments.




























The Conifer Library has been located inside Conifer High School since the school opened in 1996. Do you find this a convenient location for the library?




What Jeffco library do you use most frequently? 666 responses




Did you know that the library has a drop box and lockers for book pickup outside Mountain Resource Center?




Do you use the drop box and lockers at Mountain Resource Center? 647 responses




If Conifer had its own library building and could be open from 9:00am to 8:00pm, would you be more likely to use the Conifer Library?








Would you like to see the \$2.5 million used to create a free-standing, full-service library in the Conifer area, perhaps by leasing or purchasing vacant retail space?




Do you currently use trail connections in the Conifer area to access community destinations? 664 responses







What trail connections are important to the Conifer Community? Rank their importance to you, with 1 being the most important. ONLY ONE CHOICE PER COLUMN.







How important do you now believe LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION is to our community? 679 responses







How important do you believe it is to preserve historic buildings and places in our community? Check one





Architecture which is historically inspired but a contemporary look, 2. Large overhangs, many roof lines & steep pitched roofs; 3. Use of logs or timbers and natural stone, materials and colors; 4. 


Do you visit Meyer Ranch Open Space to hike, bike or picnic? 669 responses




Do you find parking available when you visit?




Would you utilize a shaded structure and gathering space just east of the yellow Meyer House to meet up, picnic, and enjoy the park?





How important is the CONIFER LOOP concept of connecting our community without getting onto Hwy 285? Check one.




When this CONIFER LOOP is completed, would you like to have trails for walking and biking adjacent to the roadway?






Do you know who provides your fire and Emergency Medical Services? 667 responses




Do you know what services your fire department provides? Check all that apply.



What do you think are the most important services provided by your fire department? Choose 3 640 responses




Have you ever received services from your fire department? 659 responses




If you received services from your fire department based on the following qualities: Professionalism, timely service, courteousness, how would you rate the service?






Are you familiar with Mountain Resource Center and the services it provides to the community? 664 responses



What Mountain Resource Center services have you used in the last year? Check all that apply. 545 responses




Are you aware of the Mountain Resource Center Resale Store located in the shopping center behind Staples?
